1963 INTRODUCTIONS FROM MISSION BELL GARDENS

CLAUDIA RENE (Larry Gaulter) Early to Late. 36". A fantasy of color unmatched for brilliance and harmony. Raspberry-pink standards with overtones of golden amber; rose-violet falls, with rich sienna-brown shoulders and blending to ochre-yellow at the edges, decorated with a bold burnt-orange beard. Wide ruffled petals, flaring arched falls and cupped standards contribute to beautiful form. Stalks are strong and well branched. (Glittering Amber X Mademoiselle). No. 60-37 Net 20.00

CORABANDE (Hamblen) Early to late. 36". Coral-buff standards with matching style arms; smooth white falls with a heavy border of deeper coral-buff set off by a fiery orange beard. Heavily substantced, wide petals: standards cupped, falls horizontally flared. All flower parts ruffled and laced in a pleasing manner. Strong stalks, vigorous growth. (Glittering Amber) X (Tompkins 55-162: (((Chantilly x Lavender and Gold Lace) x Reciprocal cross) x Honeyflow)). HC '60 No. H8-67 Net 20.00

BORDER BEARDED

LITTLE SAMBO (C. M. Reynolds) Early to late. 22". Inky black with deep violet undertones and a dark brown beard. Ideal form and branching. Closed standards, heavy horizontal falls, perfectly smooth hafts. A captivating little rogue to add accent to the Border Class. (Black Forest X Storm King). HC '61. No. 52-25. Net 10.00

ROBBY (Hamblen) Midseason to late. 24". Rosy cyclamen-violet standards bordered brown; rosy-tan falls edged violet. Highlighting the flower, and demanding attention, is a wide, bushy vermilion-red beard. Petals are wide, lacy and flaring. In coolish weather the flowers have a tendency to be crowded, but at the Kansas City convention, 1962, form and branching left nothing to be desired. (Valimar sib X Graduation Gift). BLACK ROSE (W. Vallette) Blackish-crimson self; bluish beard. Closed standards, flaring falls. (Starless Night) X (Sable x Casa Morena). 25.00

BLUE STAGHORN (Tell) Medium lavender-blue; pale lemon-yellow beard. Lower portion of the wide, closed standards have projections (horns) which are tipped white. (Praiseworthy X 52-24: Faught H 20 x Alicia). No. 59-34 20.00

CASCADE RIPPLES (W. Vallette) Light lavender-blue with laced petals. Standards closed; falls semi-flaring. Excellent substance. Non fading. (Twenty Grand X Ruffled Lace). HC '61 25.00

FONA (Tell) Baby-pink self, including the beard. Clean flower of good width and quality on a nicely branched stalk. Vigorous foliage; excellent increase. (Happy Birthday X June Meredith). No. 142-A 20.00

LATEST LOVE (L. Gaulter) Daintily marked white-ground plicata meeting all the requirements of a first class iris. Standards lightly stitched purple; broad white falls, hafts lightly marked; styles slightly tinted. (Sass 49-100 x Weather Bird) X (Memphis Lass x Lake Isabella). HC '61. No. 59-21 15.00

- LUZON CROSBY** (Tell) Soft, clean peach-pink self with very wide, heavily sub-stanced parts; beard deeper toned. Cupped standards and arched falls create unmistakable beauty and charm. (First Curtain x Mary Randall) X (Convention Queen x Pink Fulfillment). HC '61 No. 26 25.00
- MARIE PHILLIPS** (Tell) Light wisteria-violet self including the beard. Standards closed, falls flare to perfection and are wide and clean. We have seen nothing in the same color range comparable to this pristine beauty. (Graceline X Merry Lynn). HC '62. No. 137 25.00
- PINK DRESDEN** (W. Madsen) Translucent pale coral-pink that belies its delicate appearance by great ability to withstand weather vagaries. Wide flaring falls. Intricate lace on all petals. (Involved pedigree). No. 3-55 25.00
- RUM JUNGLE** (L. Roach) Richness, brilliance and over-all quality in a dark blend. Deep reddish copper with darker overlay on wide, flaring falls. Fully sun-resistant. Vigorous, healthy. (Inca Chief X Trim). No. 57-47 A. 25.00
- SAFFRON JEWEL** (A. and T. Abell) (Oyster-white standards, veined and edged chartreuse; falls of same coloring; flax-blue blaze and beard. Rapid grower. (Saffron Charm X Arabi Pasha). No. 56-6-1 10.00
- TAM LIN** (E. Tams) Wide, clean wisteria-orchid (violet) self, white beard tipped yellow. Marked with quality. (First Violet X Violet Harmony). HC '61 No. 8-59. 25.00
- *TRISHA** (F. McGee) Rich dark blue-purple differing from other Capitole derivatives. Darker toned beard. Wide standards, flaring falls with typical Mohr form; weather defying. (Jane Phillips X Capitola). 20.00
- TRITON** (O. Julander) Rich medium blue self with beautiful wide, closed standards and flaring falls delicately ruffled and having great width. Pale lemon-yellow beard, white-tipped. Excellent branching on strong stalks. (Harbor Blue X Whole Cloth). HC '61 25.00
- TRUTH** (H. Fischer) Beautiful, perfectly formed, simply immense white flowers artistically placed on heavy ram-rod stem. Tremendous substance. (Chivalry X Azure Skies). No. 51-65 20.00
- ZAIDA** (M. Wallace) Personality and quality in Majenta coloring, reminiscent of Patience. Smooth hafts, "Snow Flurry-ruffling". (Snow Flurry X Fabiola). 25.00

BORDER BEARDED

- FAIRY FROST** (E. Sundt) Lovely, delightfully formed small white in keeping with its height. Midribs show green; beard white shading to yellow. (New Snow X Irish Linen). No. 5587-7 D. 10.00
- LA NINA ROSA** (E. Sundt) Small flowered beauty in Orient-pink, sporting a light brick-red beard. (Party Dress X Lipstick). No. 5576-7A. 10.00
- MARCY DEE** (Tell) Translucent blend of pale iridescent peach, apricot and light violet. Closed standards, falls flaring. Entire flower daintily laced. (Cream and Tangerine X Rosedale). No. 57-68 D. 20.00

IRIS TERMINOLOGY

- AMOENA:** White standards with colored falls.
- BICOLOR:** Standards light colored, falls a different, darker color.
- BLEND:** Combination of two or more colors.
- FALLS:** Three lower petals of the flower.
- FANCY:** A riotous mixture of several colors.
- NEGLECTA:** Light blue standards, darker falls.
- PLICATA:** Stippled, dotted, or stitched margin color on light ground.
- SELF:** An iris of one, solid color.
- SIGNAL:** A patch of contrasting color at the tip of the beard.
- STANDARDS:** The three upper petals of the flower.
- STYLE ARMS:** The small, stiff segments just above the beard.
- SUBSTANCE:** The thickness of the petals.
- TEXTURE:** The surface of the petals—sheen, etc.
- VARIEGATA:** Yellow standards with deeper falls of brown, purple or red.

THE AIS AWARDS

- HC** (High Commendation): for an iris seedling, named or numbered, not introduced at time of judging.
- HM** (Honorable Mention): for an officially registered and introduced variety.
- AM** (Award of Merit): for the top 12 Tall Bearded varieties receiving HM not less than 2 or more than 5 years prior to the current season.

The following awards are equivalent to the AM:

- Knowlton Award:** for the top Border iris each year;
- Sass Award:** for the top Intermediate iris each year;
- Cook-Douglas Award:** for the top Standard Dwarf iris each year;
- Caparne Award:** for the top Miniature Dwarf iris each year;
- C. G. White Award:** for the top Arilbred variety each year; varieties must also be registered with the Aril Society International to qualify.
- DM** (Dykes Medal): the highest award an iris receives; it may be given annually to one AM winner from the 4 previous years.

- AMBER BLUSH** (Suiter '61) Warm ivory white; standards flushed pink. Heavy amber blush at hafts extends onto falls. Tangerine beard. (Apricot Glory X Top Flight). 10.00
- AMBER LACE** (Vallette '61) Laced, well formed light yellow self with good substance. (Chantilly x Tell sdlg.) X (Creamglow). 5.00
- AMETHYST FLAME** (Schreiner '58) (Plant patent 1793) Beautiful ruffled lilac-lavender, soft pink sheen; hafts touched chestnut brown. Superb substance. (Crispette) X (Lavenesque x Pathfinder). AM '60 5.00
- ANGEL'S DREAM** (E. Smith '61) Ruffled and waved medium sized white including the beard. Good branching and heavy substance. (Bro. Charles 51-53 X Mission Starlite). 15.00
- ANGEL CURLS** (Branch '57) Intense bright medium blue. Ruffled flaring
- falls; heavy substance. (Azure Skies x Cahokia) X (Cahokia). HM '58 4.00
- ANTHEM** (Schreiner '58) Fuchsia purple, subtle bronze infusion, wide bronze margin on falls. Excellent branching, substance. (Gypsy Rose x Auburn) X (Savage). HM '60 2.50
- *APIIAN WAY** (Plough '58) Mohr form violet, deepens to phlox purple at hafts. (Snow Flurry X Capitola). HM '60. 3.50
- APPLE CUP** (Noyd '61) Bright red self with brown beard. Glistening green touch at hafts adds interest. (Aria x Technicolor) X (Sdlg. x Ebony Echo). 15.00
- APPLE VALLEY** (DeForest '58) White tinted pink with deeper hafts; pink beard. Wide-petaled blossoms. ((Fairly Blush x (Cloudcap) x Paradise Pink) X (Frances Kent). HM '60 6.00
- APRICOT DANCER** (Noyd '58) Lacy flaring orange-apricot self; apricot beard. (June Bride X Temple Bells). HM '59 3.50

- ARCTIC FLAME** (Fay '60) Ruffled, flaring frosty white; heavy red beard. Excellent substance; wonderful plant habits. (Lipstick X sib). A.M. '62. Net 10.00
- ARTIC SKIES** (Fay '60) Large heavily ruffled flowers; light blue standards, clean snow-white falls. Well branched. (Albino x Cliffs of Dover) X (Butterfly Blue). HM '61 10.00

***ARDIMAC** (Sundt '60) Violet-purple standards; maroon falls; black signal. Blackish beard set off by greenish yellow hafts. (Ardrun X Ib-Mac). 4.00

AROUND ABOUT (Nebeker '61) Wide flaring white ground plicata: standards stitched blue-violet, falls bordered same, no center blaze. (Involving Tiffanja, Blue Rim, Aldura, New Hope, Tell 46-112). 15.00

AZURE HAVEN (Reynolds '57) Very wide light-blue self. Beard, haft tinted lighter. (Snow Flurry x Chivalry) X (Azure Skies). HM '57 5.00

AZURITE (Sass '60) Well-branched white ground plicata, borders lightly stitched and dotted methyl violet. (Sass sdlg. X Dancing Waters). HM '61 10.00

BABY DREAMS (Branch '62) Distinctive violet with a lighter flush in the falls; tangerine beard. Fine crimping on petal edges. (Sdlg. X Felicia). Net 15.00

BANG (Craig '55) Bold, rich brown-toned red. Wonderful form and substance. (Savage) X (Cordovan x Molten). HM '60 2.00

BARBIZON (Schreiner '61) Bright orange-tinted chestnut red. Tall, well branched; heavy substance. (From complex ancestry involving red, coppers). HM '62 7.50

BAYADERE (O. Brown '62) Attractively laced and ruffled, warm metallic brown. Firm standards; gracefully flared falls. (Bang) X ((Chantilly x Pretty Quadroon) x Mary Randall). Net 15.00

***BEIRUT** (W. Luhn '62) Dereret-sand colored. Standards veined maroon at base; falls with over-all network of maroon. Bronze beard. (Engraved X Asoka of Nepal). 4.00

IRIS PLANTING AND CULTURAL DIRECTIONS

WHEN TO PLANT. For best results plant June through September. Early planting establishes the new Iris plants before winter. This is the time to reset clumps of Iris that are crowded, generally clumps 3 to 4 years old.

WHERE TO PLANT. The ideal location for Iris is a sunny, well drained position. Sunshine at a minimum half days; Iris will not do well in deep shade. No water should stand in Iris beds. Raise beds slightly above the level of garden paths if necessary.

DEPTH TO PLANT. Place rhizomes just below the surface of the ground with the roots well spread out underneath so that rhizome is within reach of the warmth of the sun's rays while the roots beneath are in moist (not soggy) soil. Be sure to firm the soil tightly around each rhizome when planting. Follow ordinary good garden practice of watering and settling soil in newly set plants.

DISTANCE APART. This will depend on your particular plans. Generally iris are planted from 14" to 2' apart. If you desire immediate clump effect plant 8" apart in groups of 3 or more of one variety. You may have to divide and separate your plantings more often, but you will have a wonderful splash of color sooner than if you planted only one rhizome of one variety.

FERTILIZATION. Iris will thrive without feeding but will respond to its application. In the preparation of a new Iris bed, spade in a good application of compost below the roots. Then an application of a well balanced fertilizer applied as a top dressing dusted around and in between the plants in early spring or very late fall is desirable. Steamed bone meal and super-phosphate are fine top dressing materials.

CULTIVATING. Do it shallowly. Iris feeding roots are very near the surface. Keep your Iris free of weeds and do not allow neighboring plants to encroach upon them. Remember, they should have sunlight right down to the rhizome. Remove the outer leaves as they begin to brown. At all times keep litter, old Iris leaves, grasses, etc., away from the rhizomes. Clean cultivation is the finest precaution for Iris troubles.
