

SHIPPING--Daylilies can be shipped any time your weather permits planting; best planting time is early spring and fall. Iris will start in June; best planting time is early for the colder states. Hot dry states as parts of Texas and Arizona is fall. Our plants are hardy anywhere in the United States and Canada where iris and daylilies are grown with success.

TALL BEARDED IRISES

*Denotes Arilbreds

If you want lots of spring color, plant bearded iris. They are both easy to plant and to grow, but they have to have both sun and good drainage to grow well. To plant rhizome, spread out roots and cover rhizome with a thin layer of soil. Go easy on fertilizer - bone meal is good to use and is safe; a small handful per plant worked in before planting or as a side dressing.

Daylilies are fast becoming the most popular garden perennial. They will thrive almost anywhere, in almost any soil, full sun or part shade. They bloom from spring until frost, even in hot summer months when so few flowers bloom well. So plant some this year and we are sure you won't be disappointed. Plant the crown (where the leaves join the root) about one inch under the ground, being careful to spread the roots out. Plant about two feet apart, in well worked soil, that has a complete fertilizer or well-rotted manuer added several weeks before planting. Do not judge a daylily by its first year bloom as two years or more are needed to show both flowers and colors at their best. They are permanent plants and will not need to be divided for 10 years or more.
