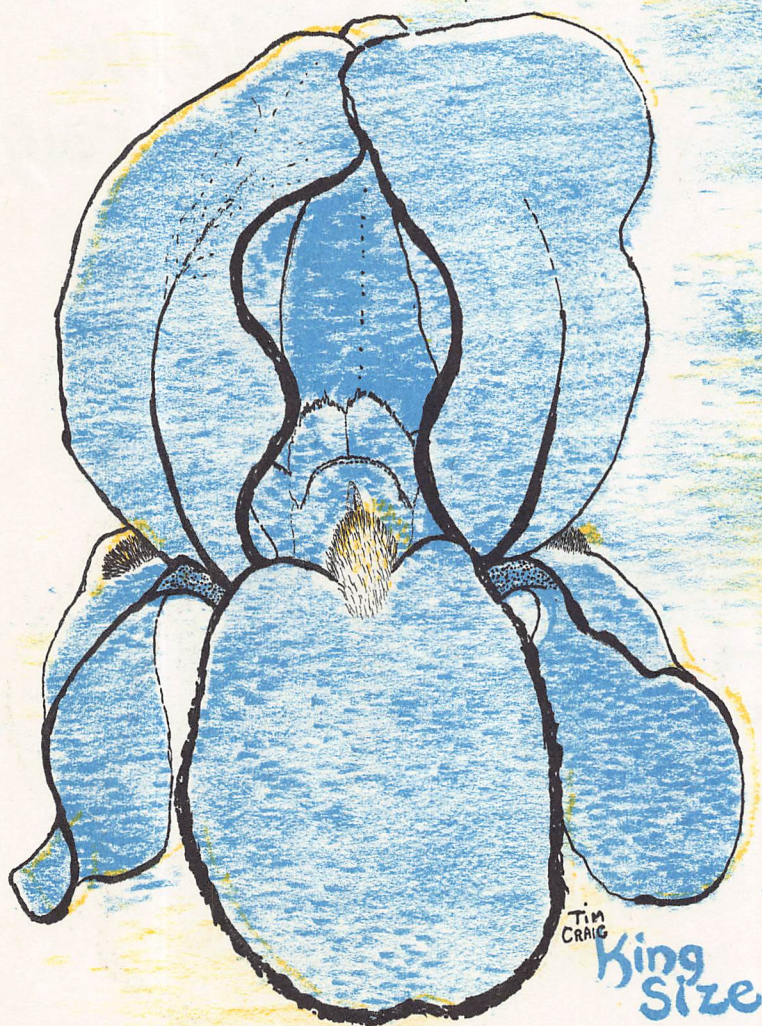
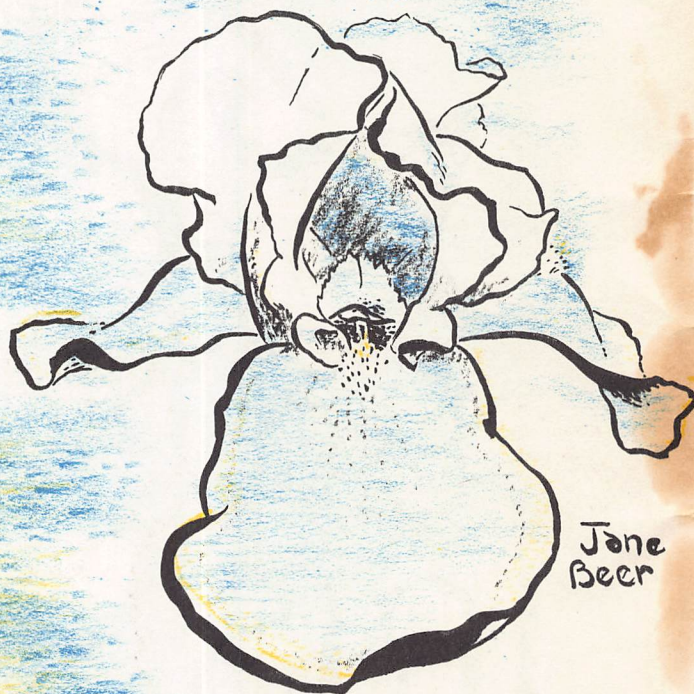
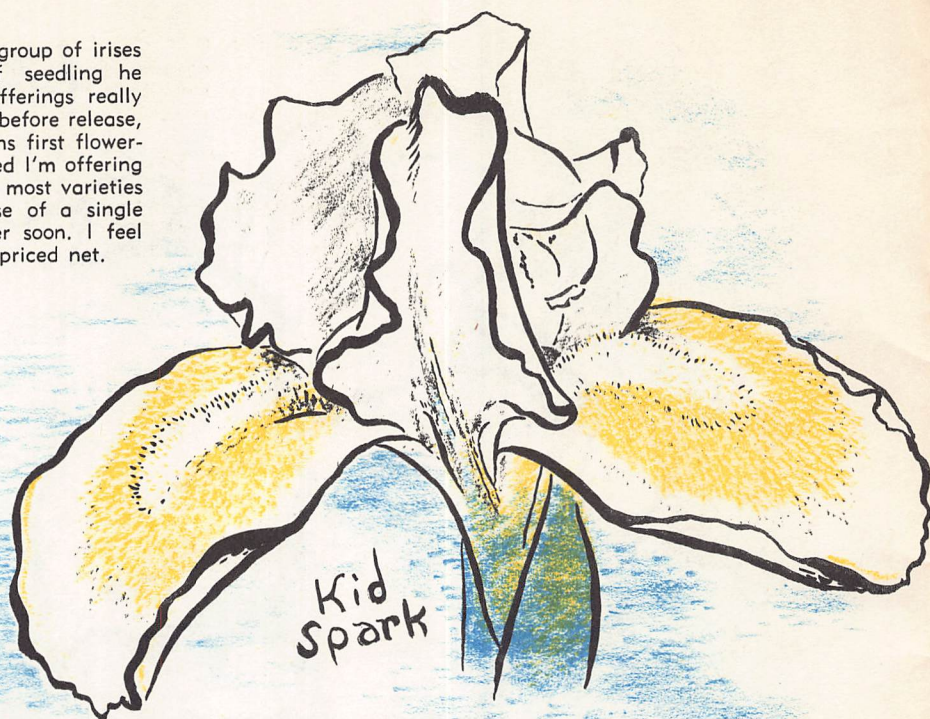

ADAMSRED (Craig '66) 2½' 20.00

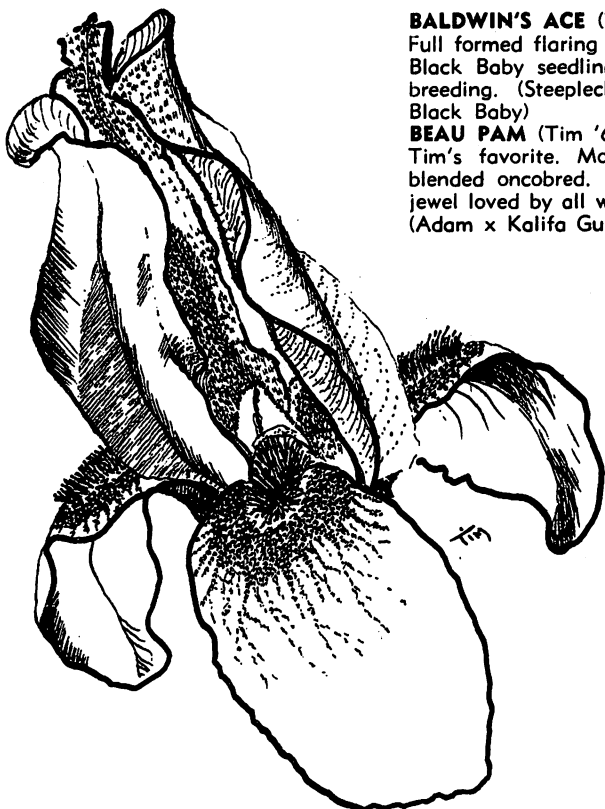
Smooth deep rich red, deeper and purer than rubient; very floriferous, strong growth, fertile.

AMBULANCE (Tim '66) 13" 5.00

Stands peony red, falls dark rose ebony with light rose ebony border and gold beard. Great vigor and profuse bloom. An outstanding intermediate. (R6-5 x Black Baby)

BABE SAN (Craig '66) 1½' ★15.00

Popcorn yellow with clean widely spread pattern and wash of absynthe on falls. Most pleasing full formed pastel bi-tone yellow border iris with much onco influence on form, pattern and the attractive olive hints in the "Arty color."



BALDWIN'S ACE (Tim '66) 2' 20.00
Full formed flaring deep violet black fertile Black Baby seedling. New blood for black breeding. (Steeplechase x Tom's Blue) x Black Baby)
BEAU PAM (Tim '66) 2½' ★ 25.00
Tim's favorite. Most elegant lilac pink blended oncobred. Nothing like it. A real jewel loved by all who have seen it. Fertile. (Adam x Kalifa Gulnare)

INK DROP (Tim '66) 6" ★ 5.00
Unique tiny deep black purple dwarf with grassy foliage and wire-like stems. Actually unclassifiable, for it comes from diploid bi-color tetraploid plic, onco, tetraploid purple, and dwarf pedigree. Moonchild x Black Baby.

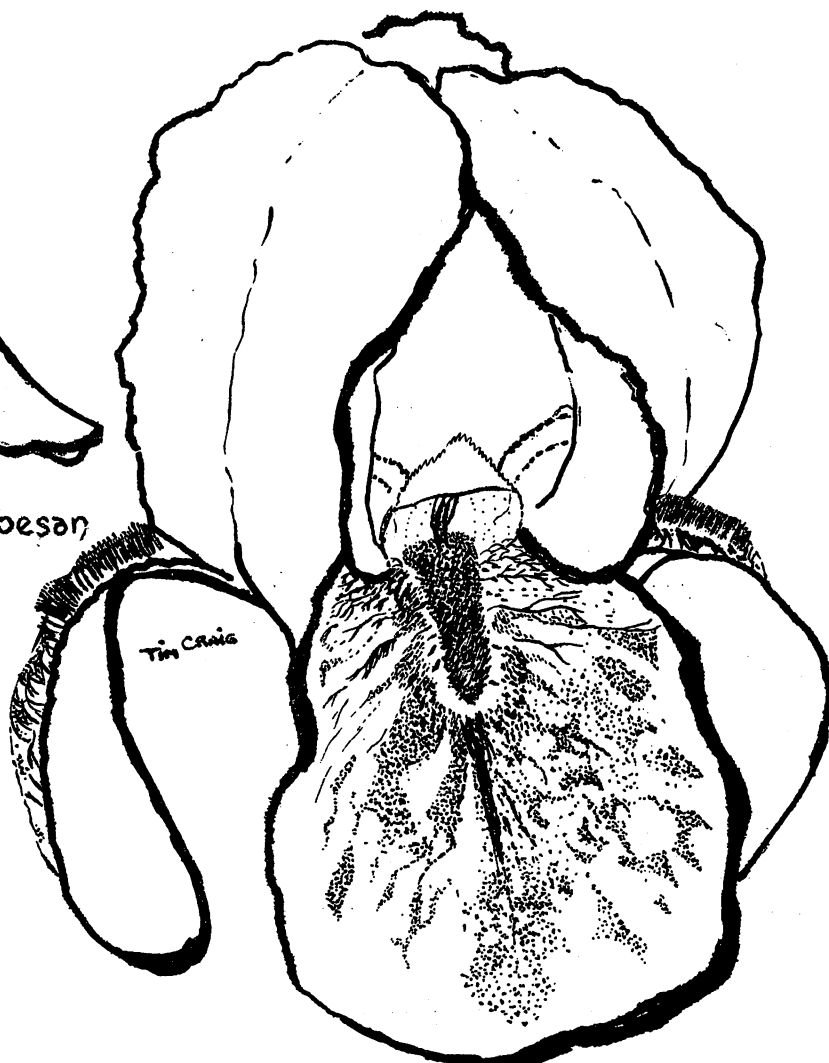

Our newest advance in white. Bigger, fuller, more classic in form. A superb white iris. (Patricia Craig x Sylvan Stream)

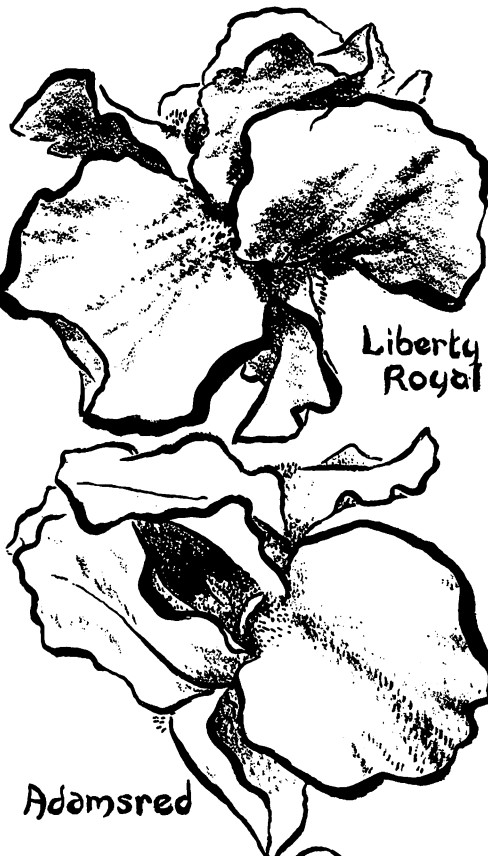
NORMA SANTILLAN (Craig '66) 1½' 20.00

Vigorous, very fertile, well branched lavender and violet neglecta with fine flaring form. (Mary McClellan x Whole Cloth)

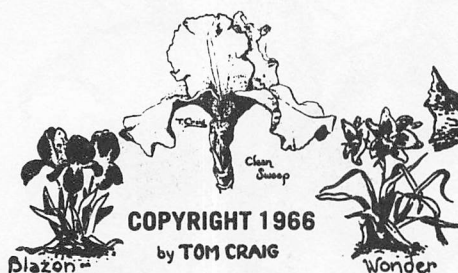

Immense violet, long flowering. Fine

Wide huge frosty clear true blue.

Highly rated new giant ruffled white.

Stately richest royal purple. Elegant! Vigorous.

BLACK HILLS (Fay '51) 4½' 75c
Tall ebony-black. Vigorous. Many flowers. Best grower and tallest of blue-blacks. For all climates.

Fine purple neglecta, brown hafts. Strong.

BLANCO (Craig '64) 3' 25.00
Big inbred cold white. Fine form, rigidly closed stands. Pure white with green buds. A breeder too!

BLAZING FIRE (McCord '61) 3' 3.00
Deepest gold falls striped red.

BLAZING VIOLET (Carlson '61) 3' 6.00
Big deep violet Blue beard. Vigorous. Fertile.

BLOOD SPOT (Tim '66) 10" E. E. 10.00
First blooming very full arabian red charmer. Big deep zanzibar spot on falls.

Giant ruffled cream-rose plic. Strong, tall perfect stem. Glorious garden iris. Difficult to seed, but top parent. Pollen extra strong.

Big full chalk white. Blue beard.

Fine deep blue bearded blue.

Fertile gray onco veined brown.

Fine silver blue. Dykes Medal.

Superb clear silver blue. One of the best, strongest and most reliable blue shade.

Classic white dotted blue. Hardy. Strong.

Giant ruffled blue. This variety and Steeplechase are the best big intense blue iris I have seen. This wins on size. I have seen no other as large or with so wide branched stem. Fertile both ways.
