Greetings,

2015 is a special milestone for us - our 90th year. Hard work seems to make time pass quickly. Permit us a brief look backwards. The year was 1925. St. Paul, Minnesota. A 45 year old German immigrant, F.X. Schreiner, turned his hobby into a business - publishing a list of bearded Iris for sale. Upon his untimely death 6 years later, F.X.'s son, Robert, assumed the reins. Eventually his siblings, Connie and Bernard (Gus) joined him. For approximately half a century, these 3 devoted their efforts to developing an outstanding breeding program, resulting in fine garden Irises, and also for establishing a standard for large, healthy rhizomes.

Change is a constant in life. In 1946 Schreiner's Gardens moved to Salem, in Oregon's fertile Willamette Valley. The 1970s saw our acreage, and number of available varieties, expand in response to a burgeoning wholesale demand for Iris. A third changing of the guard occurred in the 1980s, as Bob, Connie and Gus were succeeded by the current generation, of whom two, Dave Schreiner and Tom Abrego retired four years ago. Today, assisted by our excellent employees, Ray, Liz and Steve Schreiner honor our tradition by continuing to offer the finest in both Bearded Iris and service to the public.

Our catalog features brand new Iris - our own 2015 introductions on pages 4-8, as well as 30 additional varieties from outstanding hybridizers. No other flower can rival Bearded Iris for the variety of different and incredible colors. Our Dwarf Iris provide you with 6 weeks of bloom before the onset of Tall Bearded bloom. Reblooming Iris unfurl a second time in the summer and fall. Lovely Beardless Iris open with our Siberians, and the month to follow Louisianas. Whether you have just a little bit of room, or an entire side yard, colorful Iris will lift your spirits each Spring.

Areas around the globe have suffered some extreme water conditions in recent years. The good news is that Iris are hardy, and can take it.

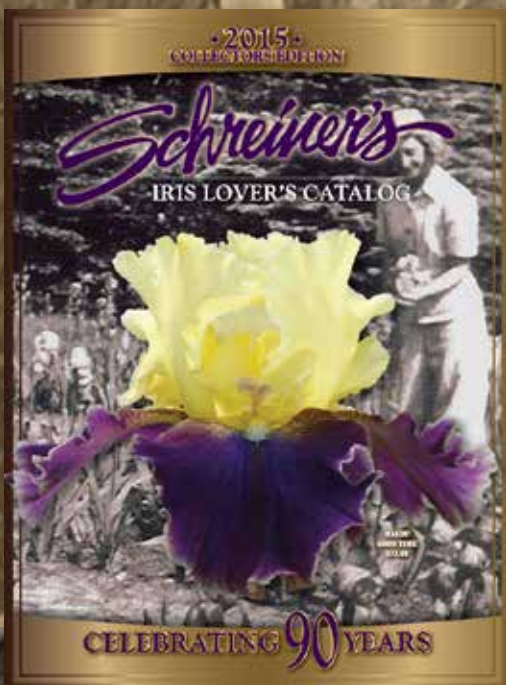
MAKIN' GOOD TIME (Schreiner 2015) L. 40" \$55.00

Here is a bicolor with few in its class, and even fewer with the finely chiseled form and sublime coloration of *Makin' Good Time*. Pale primrose yellow standards are perfectly shaped. Grape purple falls are washed with inviting violet tones, and outlined with a catchy white border. Distinctive white veining flanks a light beard. SPiRiT OF ALEJANDRO (Schreiner 2015) M. 30" \$50.00

Alejandro Vargas, for 35 years, made Schreiner's Gardens proud. He was everything you'd want in an employee - loyal and hard-working. He was everything you'd want in a man - warm, kind and fun. Late last year Alejandro passed away. The shock is still reverberating-35 years is a long time. This poised and composed bloom is dedicated to our Alejandro. Contrasting tones allow petals and style arms to be clearly visible, and the result is pleasing. The reverse of the falls, and zonal spots on the falls and standards enliven the overall cornflower blue, as shown in our photo **at left**. Although not tall, at 30", this is a dramatic Iris, with good branching and 8 buds on a stem. In every bloom will be Alejandro's great smile. Seedling #PP651-3

HIGH SCHOOL HONEY (Schreiner 2015) M. 43" \$55.00

An absolute siren, *High School Honey* alluringly beckons, lighting up any garden with its warm pastel tones. The clean separation between the dandelion yellow standards and the earthen-orange falls, places this tall, debonair sweetheart a step ahead in her class. A bright zonal pattern bridges the sun and the earth, as shown in our photo **at right**. Each sturdy stalk has 3 branches, yielding 9 buds per stem. Seedling #WW993-1

F.X. Schreiner's galvanizing colors and proportion will grab you. Slightly blue-infused at the midribs, the standards are otherwise a clean white. The thrilling, French blue falls flare with élan. Yellow beards unify white striping, as pictured **at left**. This ruffled specimen features good substance and a satisfying Iris stem habit - 4 branches with 9 buds on a stalk. Ninety years ago F.X. (Francis Xavier) Schreiner printed a modest catalog, and began selling bearded Iris. What would his reaction have been to *F.X. Schreiner?* The blue dominant amoena was non-existent when he was alive. He once wrote that he'd give anything for 50 more years to work with Bearded Iris. Seedling #VV178-1

DESTINATION FABULOUS (Schreiner 2015) M. 38" **\$55.00**

A festive lavender Iris, like *Destination Fabulous*, is a happy addition to every garden, because the color complements a wide range of other shades, as our photo shows **at right**. The amethyst lavender suggests refinement and something special. Form, balance and proportion are each laudable. Sitting atop the striking zonal spot is a shining orange beard. Conspicuous veining overlays the falls, adding sprightliness. Robust stalks deliver 3 branches, with 6 buds, some double socketed. Seedling #RR1481-1

GRAFENAU REMEMBERED (Schreiner 2015) L. 40" **\$50.00**

Grafenau, Germany is a small city in Southeast Germany, where F. X. Schreiner lived until emigrating to St. Paul, MN as a boy in 1886. Its namesake, a tall plum purple plicata, presents demurely closed standards as the backdrop for the captivating cascade of cream coating the plum-encircled falls. See our photo **below**. *Grafenau Remembered* opens late in the season and has excellent branching and good growth habits. 125 years after F.X. departed, we paid a brief visit to Grafenau, and reflected on how actions of long ago can have far-reaching consequences. We relax and breath deep when we come upon *Jimmy G*. White, silver white - everywhere. Like being immersed in a cloud. *Jimmy G* imparts peacefulness. It's big and broad, with crinkled falls, domed standards, and excellent branching. This is a marvelously proportioned, lush specimen, as indicated **at right**. *Jimmy G* is named for a wonderful man - the late James Giancarlo, who died suddenly last summer. James was a frequent visitor to our gardens. Unfortunately for us, we never met him. His daily posts on Facebook always featured Iris. James touched many lives as a theatrical director, and after his Memorial Service, each person received an Iris, captioned, "See you in the Spring. Love, Jim." As Jimmy G would say, we have an *Absolute Crush* on this Iris. Not one of the over 800 varieties of Tall Bearded Iris we grow combines *Absolute Crush's* colors - powder puff standards and pale jacaranda falls. This soul-satisfying, beautifully formed amoena exudes serene elegance, as displayed in our photo **at left**. A flicker of yellow outlines the standards, and a meandering lavender border defines the winsome falls. Sporting an orange beard, 3 double-socketed branches, on 36" stems, *Absolute Crush* will be abloom late in the season when other varieties are but a memory. Seedling # TT1157-1

This near self, only the black center of the falls breaks the pattern, is another example of the ever-expanding palette of Iris colors. Currently there are few varieties of this wine-colored purple. A lighter medial stripe runs down from the purple beard. See in our photo **below**, the wide, ruffled petals of *For Veronica*. With excellent substance and 8 buds on 3 branches. Veronica Haag, our Grandmother, was married to F.X. Schreiner, our Grandfather and the originator of Schreiner's Gardens. Veronica was a hard-working, giving person, who outlived her husband by 47 years. She baked delicious pies - some the color of *For Veronica*. Seedling #WW106-A

Besides having good growth habits and increase, *Passion For Fashion* has illustrious parents - *Cherry Blossom Song* and *Brazilian Holiday*. We guarantee *A Grape Fit* will engender an outburst. Such a boisterous, welcoming rosy violet plicata will perk up the most staid gardener. Domed standards beautifully shelter silhouetted style arms. And the wide, cup-shaped falls’ white ground is heavily peppered with a 1/2” ring of aster violet, as seen in our photo **at left**. It was a realization that we have no other Iris precisely this color, although there is a faint resemblance to 31 year old *Jesse’s Song*. 35” in height with 3 branches, 7 buds, some double-socketed. CENTURY BOUND (Schreiner 2015) M. 40” BONUS

What better way to be introduced to the classic color combination – blue and white, than with the show-stopping *Century Bound*? Pure, sculpted white standards are a vision. A splash of ultramarine blue-purple dominates the falls, which are artistically fringed in lavender. The white blaze is punctuated with a gentle yellow beard, flanked by chestnut hash marks. See our photo **at left**. 8 buds on 40” stalks. White is the color produced by all the colors of the visible spectrum, and all the colors we have brought forth in the last 90 years. Here is another Iris to lengthen your bloom season, arriving when most varieties have concluded their display. *Servin’ Up Sparkle* is a true beauty. Full-petaled and with fine substance, the standards have a whisper of lavender. Lovely laciness adds to the allure, as the photo **at left** shows. Fifty-four years ago we wrote in our catalog, “A white is acceptable at all times and has universal appeal, probably because we all instinctively admire this symbol of purity and innocence.” 7-10 buds on 36” high-stalks. Seeing the unblushing *Let’s Fly* for the first time equals the excitement of whizzing down the runway in a plane. The extravagant mélange of colors in the falls – orange beard amidst white striping, all encircled by a double band of red and caramel, is triumphantly topped off on the standards, with a color looking unlike any of them – glorious saffron, as our photo **at left** illustrates. A sun-ripened peachy apricot hue paints the standards of this pink bitone. An engaging shrimp-pink shade overlays the same peachy apricot tint in the falls. Our picture **below** accurately shows the further embellishment of tangerine beards surrounded by a highlight of yellow. This prolific bloomer bursts into glory with 10 buds per stalk.

DREAM TICKET (Lauer 2006) ML. 36"

 *Dream Ticket* is a pink lavender bicolor, cool and morning fresh, suggesting serenity and grace. See our photo **below**. The standards are well-formed, and a pleasing, soft pink. The center of the wide falls is white with a breath of lavender, which becomes more predominant on the outer half inch. Gentle ruffles add to the appeal. Definitely a real advance in the lavender pink bitone class. Pronounced sweet fragrance. HM '08.

A great blend, the real deal, in an under-represented class, and also one which complements so many other colors found in the garden. The standards are rose with orange amber undertones, and the falls are the reverse. Vermilion beards add to the appeal of this beautifully colored, and perfectly formed gem. MAGIC HAPPENS (Ghio 2006) EM. 35"

In the world of Iris, an entirely new color simply does not materialize in a single day. Hybridizing progress is incremental. Aptly named *Magic Happens* is an example of a somewhat new color motif. Thirteen years ago, the hybridizer introduced *Vapor*, a rosy striped amoena. Now we have a singular purple striped amoena. Notice in our photo on **page 11** how the prominent orange beards, along with the veined, warm hafts, and gold touches on the white standards, make magic. HM '08.

 A supremely beautiful color. *Mythology* sets itself apart - rare is the blue in the grayed blue-violet class. Notable also, it's a reverse amoena. The falls are paler than the standards. This great hybridizer continues 2 traditions - coming up with bang-on names, and introducing excellent reds. 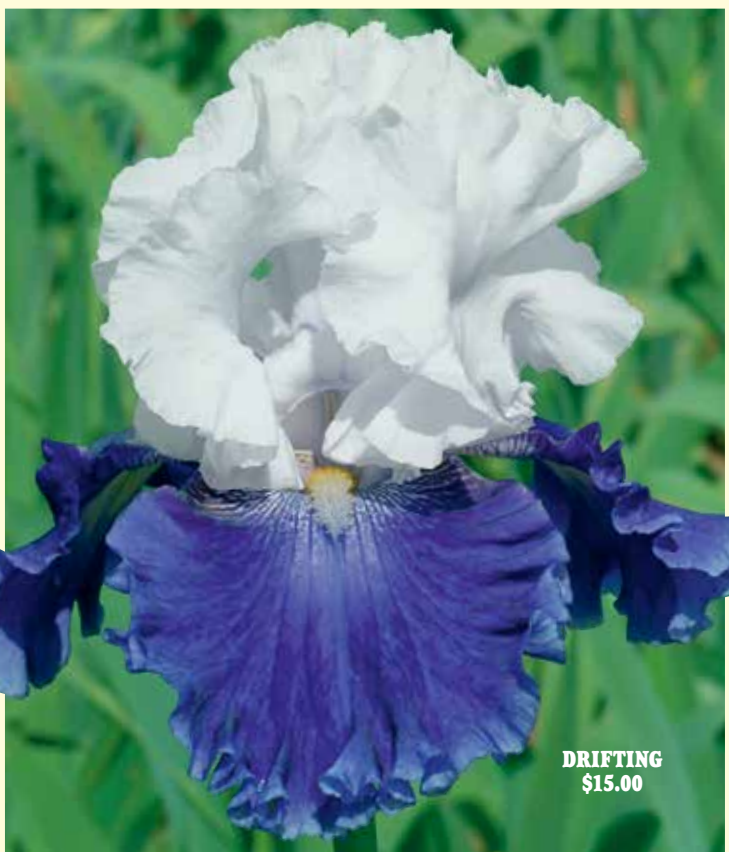

This plicata's striking broad ruffled falls are marked with a distinct 1/2" stitched perimeter of carmine red as shown in our illustration **above**. The standards repeat the same theme with a redder flush. The ground color presents a superb contrast of snowy white. Each lofty stem has three to four branches and proudly displays 11 to 14 buds.

DRIFTING (Schreiner 2011) M. 40" **\$15.00**

The light airiness of this impeccable blue amoena will freshen up your garden. Billowing white standards perfectly complement the elegantly ruffled hyacinth blue falls, as shown in our photo **below**. Held on 40" stems, its 4 1/4" x 6" flowers dominate the floral landscape. The stem habit is also splendid with three to four branches displaying 9 to 12 buds on each stalk.

Sordid Lives illustrates the attraction of temptation. Besides blazing a new trail in color classes, this exciting Iris reflects pleasure. The falls' personality is self-evident with festive striations overlaying the attractive red mixed with yellow. A quarter inch yellow border, as shown in our photo **above**, lends the perfect finishing touch to the inviting falls. Contrasting snow white standards feature a precise wire of gold on the edges. Its large blossoms and high bud count are guaranteed to attract the paparazzi. HM '11. AM '13.

BETTER THAN BUTTER (Black 2010) EML. 41" **\$20.00**

 We scoffed. Better than butter? THIS *Better Than Butter* is convincing. Soft yellow hues land everywhere with a light touch. Silky white standards are flaxen fringed as our photo illustrates on **page 13**. And the white ground of the shapely falls are flushed with dulcet yellow veining. Finally, *Better Than Butter* displays substance, robust growth, and a slight musky fragrance, proving it's the real thing. HM '12. AM '14.

ELIZABETHAN AGE (Baumunk 2005) EM. 33" **\$17.50**

Elizabethan Age won the prestigious 2013 Wister Medal, and continues to capture eyes from across the garden. The form is very good. Light purple standards lighten to apricot on the periphery. Light veinations overlie the darker purple open falls. Typical of luminatas, attention is pulled inward by the white blaze surrounding the yellow beard, and the warm style arms, as you see in our photo on **page 13**. Good growth habits. HM '07. AM '09. WM '13.

MAGICAL (Ghio 2008) EM. 37" **\$16.00**

Magical is garnering rave reviews as one of the "most gorgeous light pink Iris on the market today. It makes a spectacle in the garden, and almost every stem is a show stem." - *Tempo Two Iris Gardens*. "Branched and budded stalks with flowers that remain fresh for 4 days. Rip City is blessed with amazing attributes. First and foremost, its shiny color is as close to true carmine red as any Iris we know. Secondly, its flower form is pleasantly ruffled and classically erect. And finally *Rip City* has superlative branching and bud count (thick stems bearing 10-13 double- and triple-socketed buds per stem) See our photo on [page 66](#). HM '03.

SOFIA (B. Blyth 2003) VE.-EM. 34" **\$12.50**

The hybridizer, originator of many excellent yellow amoenas, has brought forth a most unique version with *Sofia*. Its ruffled muted yellow falls are edged with white, forming a subtle contrast to the pure white standards, as shown in our photo on [page 66](#).

SOLAR FIRE (Tasco 2003) M. 36" **\$10.50**

 The combination of bronze-gold standards and oxblood falls will raise your garden temperature. Orange beards, flaring red flounces, rippling falls, enticing fragrance reaching a crescendo...It all spells sizzle. Pictured on [page 67](#).

WINTERFEST (Schreiner 2005) ML. 40" **\$9.00**

IMMORTALITY (Zurbrigg 1982) M. & RE. 29" **\$8.00**

 Our photo [above](#) shows a medium-sized formally shaped pure white self with light lemon yellow beards. *Immortality* is perhaps best known as THE reblooming wonder. Its plant vigor is superb, flaunting two to three stems per clump. Strong sweet fragrance. HM '86. AM '90.

ANCIENT ECHOES (Blyth 1998) ML. 34" **\$7.50**

 This big bold variegata has inherited the personality of its esteemed parent, *Supreme Sultan*. Quarter-inch tawny rose border on reddish black falls, emphasizing the loping ruffles as shown in our photo on **page 71**. Invitingly sweet fragrance.

COMPANY RED (Schreiner 2010) ML. 36" **\$12.50**

Here is a real outpost on the frontier of red Iris. It averages exceptionally large 4¼" x 6½" flowers. The pleasing color pattern will mesmerize you. As shown in our photo on **page 71**, claret standards and darker maroon falls create an unusual bitone in ruby-red colors. This two-tone trait was certainly inherited from its pollen parent, *Brazilian Holiday*. Three-branched stems produce 7-8 buds per stalk.

DANCE THE NIGHT AWAY (Schreiner 2010) ML. 39" **\$12.50**

What a novel offbeat color! Just when you think you've seen all the pigments an Iris can be - a new one appears. This rose and burnt copper-watermelon blend produces a fascinating bitone medley. The bubbling effervescence of its flower form, captured in our picture on **page 70**, adds to the ebullient magic. Each stout flower is presented on superbly branched stems bearing 6-7 buds.


DANGEROUS MOOD (Schreiner 2004) EM. 36" **\$7.50**

Taking the best traits of its parents, *Rare Treat* and *American Classic*, this combination of blue and white will enchant you with its sharp plicata stitching. This clean lemon self glows like a full summer moon as seen in our photo on **page 71**. *Goodnight Moon's* enticing flaxen shades beckon from immense (6½" x 4") superbly substantanced flowers with flawlessly ruffled form.

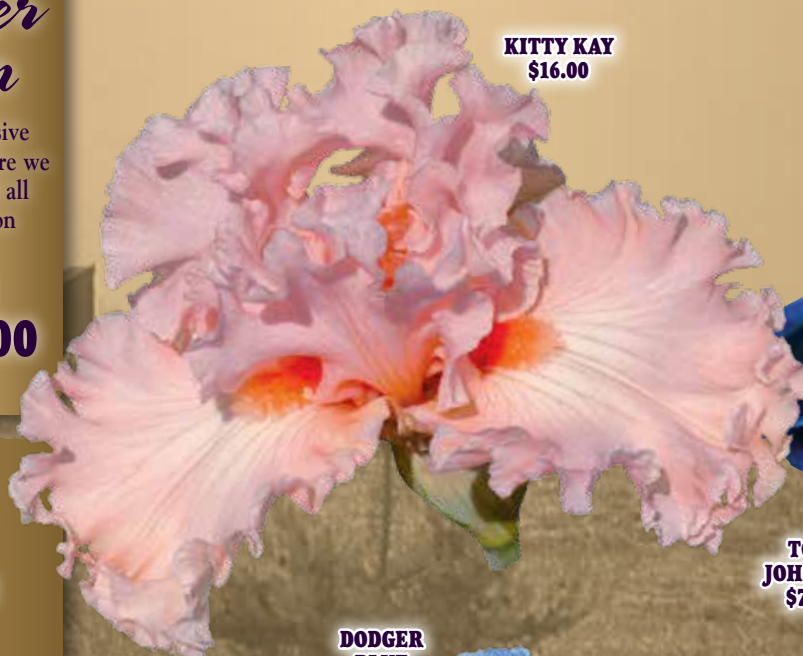

AMAS (Foster 1885) E. 25"
