Greetings and great thanks to our many friends and customers, whom we have served in past years, and whom we hope to continue serving.

Garden visitors are always welcome, and we will have iris blooming from April, through May, into mid-June, then repeat bloomers from September and October to killing frost.

Hemerocallis will begin in May, reach peak bloom in June, and repeat bloomers will continue to killing frost.

We are hybridizers and will have many seedlings in bloom during the 1963 season, plus our two fine Arilbred breeder's iris, introduced this season, as described below:

IFTAH-EL-BAB—(Kalifa Abra X C.G.W.—A-2)

Erythrite purplish red (WILSON CHART), marked and heavily splashed in deep maroon, wide bronze beard. Large blooms, good form, substance, two branches, 30 inch stalk, 4 to 6 blooms. HAS THE HIGHEST FERTILITY OF ANY ARILBRED POLLEN PARENT IN OUR ENTIRE GARDENS, SETTING SEED WHERE ALL OTHERS HAVE FAILED, EVEN ON DIFFICULT PURE ARIL SPECIES. GIVES GOOD SIGNALS IN VERY FIRST (F-1) GENERATION. FEW PLANTS AVAILABLE FOR 1963 SALES..... \$20.00

ECH-CHAMS-HARRA—(C.G.W.)—W-1 X Kalifa Baltis)

Brightest pure deep yellow, lightly marked in tan on the standards, deeply marked in black on the falls, the markings being linear, running with the long axis of the falls.
