

NOTE ABBREVIATIONS USED

The highest award an Iris has received to date and the year it was awarded is noted after the name of the Iris. Abbreviations are as noted:

DM Dykes Medal

AM Award of Merit

HM Honorable Mention

HC High Commendation

S is used for standards (the top 3 petals).

F is used for falls (the bottom 3 petals).

* Where the S (standards) are one colour, and the F (falls) are a different colour, the colour of the S is mentioned first, an asterisk * is then inserted, and the colour of the F is mentioned after the *.

BRD is used for beard.

REB is used for rebloomer, an Iris that may rebloom in the fall.

PLI is used for plicata, an Iris that has a stitched or stippled margin colour on a white or cream background.

You will notice in this price list a very different pricing method than is used by Iris dealers. We feel this pricing method has merit, and is to the advantage of you, the purchaser.

We have tried to make the price of each Iris low enough that the savings you make may be used to purchase extra Iris that you really want. You see, we DO NOT SEND YOU GIFT OR PREMIUM IRIS. You can order them or pocket the savings you make on our prices.

We think this is common sense. Do you agree?

SHIPPING SEASON

Orders will be shipped as received, usually August 5th to the 19th. However, we want the Iris to be removed from the packing and planted as quickly as possible, so if you are to be away during part of this time notify us when you want your Iris SENT and we will try to oblige.

We will acknowledge all orders and notify you if your order cannot be shipped complete.

GUARANTEE

All rhizomes are guaranteed to be healthy, true to name, of good quality, and labeled. If there are any errors or you are not completely satisfied notify us promptly, also state what you would like done. If any Iris fails to grow notify us within four months of date of receipt.

TERMS

Cash with order or 25% with order and balance before shipment. Tall bearded orders of \$5.00 and over will be prepaid. Please add 35¢ for postage and handling on orders under \$5.00. Exchange must be added to cheques. Ontario customers add sales tax.

VIOLET DELIGHT (Laur '68)

T.B. Seedling 87A61 (Amethyst Flame X Whole Cloth)
Registered 1967. A.I.S. color classification RV1F.

A strong purple self on the violet side, lighter area at haft. Dark orange-yellow beard, tip is near colour of falls. Height here is around 36". It blooms a very long midseason.

This Iris seems to have done quite well where it has been guested out. Personally I have found it an excellent increaser but sometimes a reluctant parent. It blooms prolifically every year here. Blooms are large and ruffled, usually with three or four out at one time. It could make a very good show Iris. The standards and falls are in good proportion and well held. Substance is excellent and the branching is very good.

Violet Delight had the honour of winning the W.J. Moffat Silver Cup for the best seedling at the Canadian Iris Society show in 1967.

JUDEAN STAR (Laur '68)

\$20.00

Oncocyclus seedling 023A59 (Judean Charmer X Judean Silver). Registered 1967. A.I.S. color classification VP4Wcm.

Standards are a very pale violet veined strong violet. Falls are white with gold flush and are veined maroon. The large black signal spot has a maroon flush.

This pure oncocyclus hybrid is a great step forward in hardiness in its class. It is as easy to grow and bloom as the average regeliocyclus. The flower is immense and quite impressive. Petal substance and strength of stalk are very good. Falls are reflexed in the manner of the oncocyclus species.

This Iris, as all pure arils do, needs special growing methods. Not complicated methods, but different from the tall bearded iris. It is not for the inexperienced gardener unless growing instructions are followed closely.
