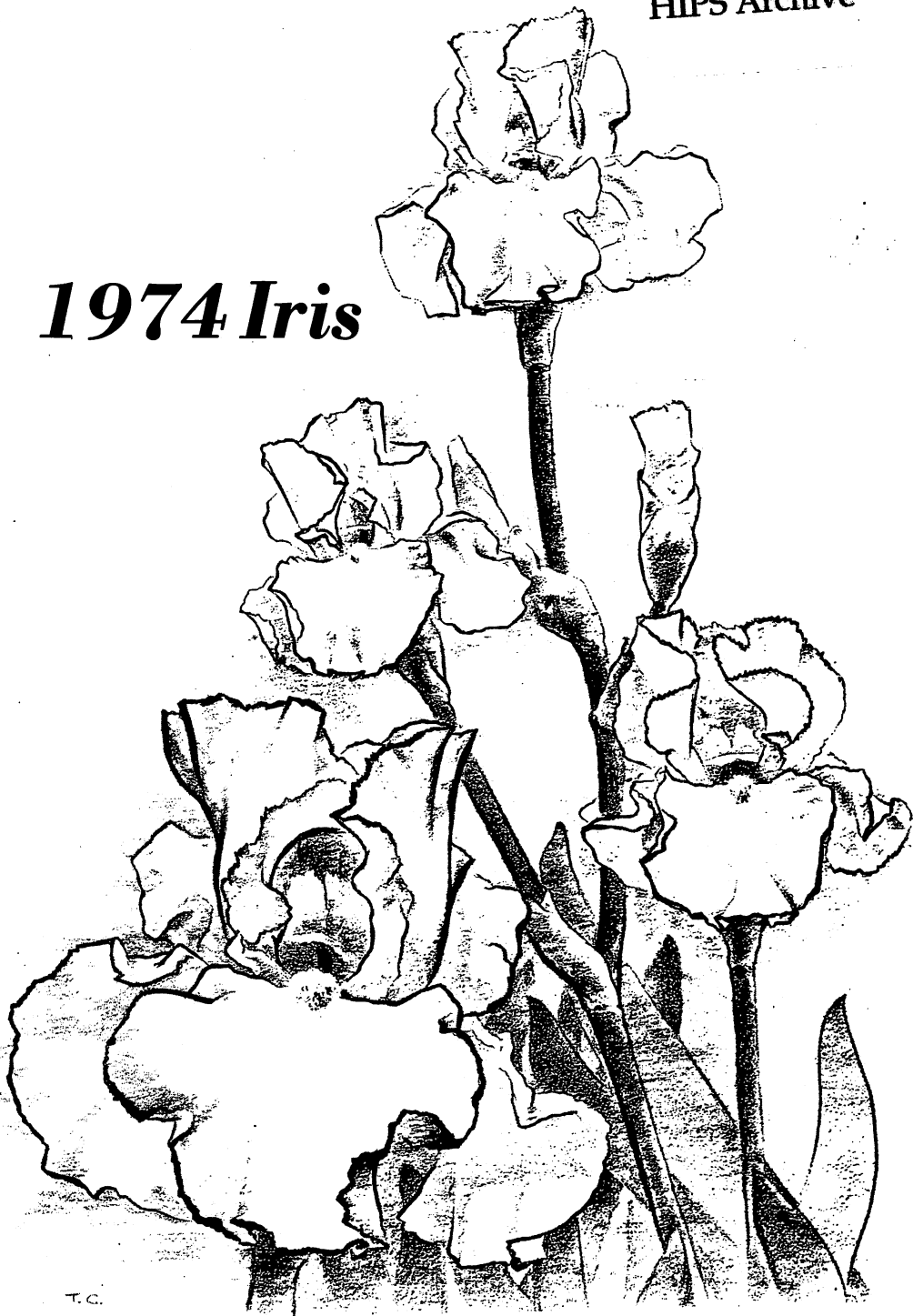

Greetings Irisarians!

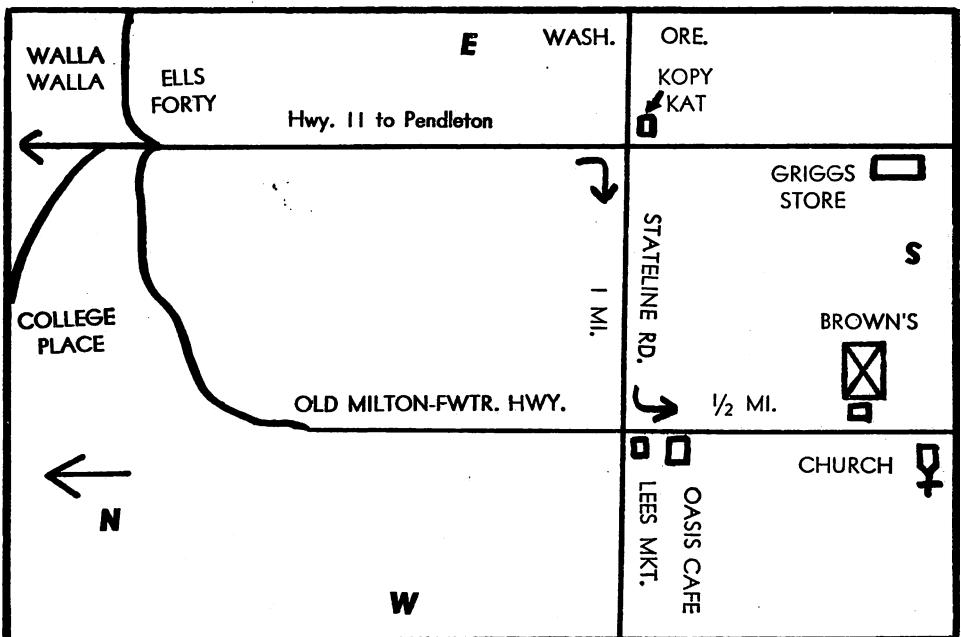
Our sincere thanks to all of our good friends and customers; old and new. We are truly grateful for your patronage and have enjoyed serving you over the past 'twenty-odd' years.

CAMEO PINKNET \$20.00

(O.L. Brown '74). TB, Mid. 28". Lovely flowers with firmly held standards and flared, lightly fluted falls. Standards are Venetian pink with daintily crimped edges a bit lighter. Falls are white with pink reverse which shows on the crimped edges; hafts flushed pink and beards deep pink. Two branches, spur and terminal. Dainty and pretty. Sdlg. No. 9-16D18. Involved pinks x Chinese Coral X Buffy.

GAY WINGSNET \$7.50

(O.L. Brown '74). IB, Mid. 26". Strongly held standards are apricot yellow with pink infusion. Horizontal falls are peach with large distinct spot pattern of apricot-brown. Beards are tangerine to pale yellow. 5 buds. Sdlg. No. 9-3B50, Gay Whisper X Lenna M.

INSTANT CHARMNET \$25.00

(O.L. Brown '74). TB, M, 38". Beautifully formed flowers with ruffled domed standards and semi flaring falls. Standards are Neyron rose, ruffled falls are same with lavender saturation in edges and a warm amber pink blend on hafts. Glistening finish overall with beards of chinese coral. Three branches plus terminal, 9 to 10 buds. HC'73 under No. 9-10F2. (Rippling Waters x Pipes Of Pan x Dawn Flight) X Sib.

MYSTIC VISIONNET \$20.00

(O.L. Brown '74). TB, ML, 28". 5 inch flowers. Ruffled standards of light salmon pink are strongly held; fluted, arched falls are light salmon with smooth amber pink hafts. Eye catching beards have deep purple base with hairs brushed tangerine and tend to change color when viewed from different angles. 7 buds. Should be interesting breeding stock. Sdlg. No. 8-1A90. Lightning Ridge X Christmas Time.

NEON MAGICNET \$25.00

(O.L. Brown '74). TB, ML, 35". Widely flaring orange with closed standards, ruffled petals and heavy substance. Outstanding feature is the long rich orange, plushlike beard of half inch width. Very striking and colorful. Nice stalk with 7 buds. No. 9-19E1, won the "Best Seedling Award" at 1973 Region 13 meeting. (Chinese Coral x Pink sdlg. X Orange Parade) X Light Up x Chinese Coral.

QUEEN OF HEARTSNET \$25.00

(O.L. Brown '74). TB, Mid. 34". The iris you've all been waiting for! Domed standards of Coral pink with deeply laced edges. Wide hafted, arched falls of pearly white with coral buff hafts and decorative coral buff lacy edging. Showy beards of coral pink. Ideal branching with 10 buds. HC '72 under No. 70-6F5. Grandiflora x Christmas Time X Buffy. Sure to win your heart!

(O.L. Brown '66) Ruffled domed standards are greenish buff. Arched falls are a bit lighter with smooth amber hafts and thick brownish beard; ruffled edges are color of standards. Tall, well branched stalks. H M '67.

(V. Lorenz '70) Domed, eggshell white standards lightly flushed pink at midribs; semi flared falls are pink with red beards. A new addition to this difficult class.

(Carlson '68) Closed standards are rosy buff, semi-flaring falls are browner with a light area around a shrimp red beard. Popular. H M '69.

FLAMING DAWN \$3.50
(L. Peterson '67) Delightfully ruffled pastel bicolor having peach pink standards and violet-blue falls with burnt orange beards. H M '68.

FLAMING STAR \$10.00
(Plough '67) Brilliant orange of medium size with orange-pink flush in both standards and falls. Bright orange red beards. H M '68.

FLATTERY \$10.00
(Gatty '71) Light chicory blue self with large cream beard. Ruffled petals; well branched stalks. H M '72.

(O.L. Brown '73) Tall, well branched stalks portray the lovely ruffled flowers. Standards orchid pink; falls lavender rose with intense orange-red beards.

(Keppel '69) Pastel bicolor plicata. Closed standards are warm white, flared falls have wide border of soft violet with deeper violet plicata markings near haft. H M '70.

(E. Smith '67) Lavender pink with frills and lace. Bright tangerine beard. H M '70.

FULL TIDE \$20.00
(O.L. Brown '72) Beautifully ruffled and fluted wisteria blue. Standards domed, falls wide and flaring with pale blue beards. Excellent branching and bud count. H M '73.

GALA AFFAIR \$10.00
(R. Brown '69) Standards orchid with tan edges. Semi flaring falls are red violet with tan border and gold beards. The name is quite fitting. H M '71.

(L. Peterson '68) Colorful bicolor. Butter-scotch standards; wine red falls flushed violet blue below deep yellow beard. A M '71.

(Schreiner '65) Coppery brown standards laced at tips; falls yellow-gold with a bit of lace on lower edges. Bright—has excellent garden value. H M '66.

IVORY FLUTE \$7.50
(R. Brown '69) Ruffled ivory with green tone and light yellow hafts. Well branched.

(Schreiner '66) Deep, glossy ruby-red with attractive rounded form. Lightly ruffled flowers have smooth hafts and bronze-purple beard. A M '70.
