



## INTRODUCTIONS FOR 1975

SILKEN BLEND (Foster) E-M. 33". Best described as a cream and green amoena. Ruffled wide standards are a delectable blend of cream, turquoise, violet and gold, veined green - sometimes edged pale blue-violet. Fringed style crests are gold striped green. Broad slightly recurved falls are a rich yellow with iridescent overlay of blue-green. Maroon vertical line signal. Matching dotting of maroon around dark old gold beard. Different. #74-5-7. Sdls. 67-2-2 X 66-28-4, involving Beisen Aga, Imaret, Bethlehem Star and Wilkes' GMB X MG8. \$20

SPICED WINE (Foster) E-M. 29". Beautifully formed exotic flower in Wisteria Blue patterned Maroon Red. Domed and overlapped standards are Wisteria Blue RHS 640/2 veined Rose-Maroon. Smoothly recurved falls are greyed Wisteria Blue thickly dotted Maroon overall. The long V-shaped signal is deeper Maroon - the beard is gold tipped grey. #72-10-10. (I. susiana X I. gatesii) X Shalom. \$20

SUNSPUN (Foster) E-M. 27". Standards are cream veined Primrose-Yellow RHS 601/1. Stylecrests deeper RHS 601 striped green. The recurved falls are Primrose Yellow 601/2 dotted garnet-brown around the sharp maroon signal and smooth brown beard. Occasional violet flecking. The lower fall is chartreuse-green. A sib of SPICED WINE, ARIL ARROW, JUDEAN JEWEL and GARDEN OF BABYLON. Useful for breeding - the only yellow among many of various violet tones. #72-10-7. (I. gatesii x I. susiana) X Shalom. \$20

The above three introductions are offered at \$50 for all.

RUBY IMP (Foster) MDB 7". A trio of dark reds describes this "imp". Standards are Maroon RHS 1030/3 veined darker, with styles the same. Flaring falls are Ruby Red RHS 827/1, bordered Beetroot Purple RHS 830/3. Violet beard and texture veining. On a sunny day, it really glows. #72-30-1. Regards X Lilli-Var. \$5

WINE PIXIE (Foster) SDB 10". Captivating petite beauty in a vibrant color scheme. Ruffled standards and fringed styles are a lively Spectrum Violet RHS 735/3. Flaring velvety fluted falls in Dahlia Purple 931/2 with a black overlay, are edged Spectrum Violet. Violet beard, blue pollen. Branched, with 3 blooms. #72-30-4. Regards X Lilli-Var. \$5

Many of them give us two bursts of bloom, first with the arils and arilbreds, then about five or six weeks later. They have few cultural problems, and make large clumps in just a year or so. These will win many blue ribbons for you!

PACIFIC CHARMER (Stambach '67) 26". E-M. Although distributed some time ago, this elegant beauty has never been officially introduced. So that it may be eligible for awards, we are listing it for 1975. A smooth white of great purity, lightly fluted and accented by golden veining in the heart of the flower. Branched with up to 7 blooms. Quality! #3-60. Agnes James X seedling. \$3

GARDEN DELIGHT (Stambach '71) 13". Rich yellow ruffled standards and styles. Falls deeper, ruffled and fluted with reddish-brown thumbprint and dark brown veining to 1/2" of petal edges, giving a border effect. Delightful and the longest-blooming of any in our garden. #106-64. Western Queen X Claremont Indian. \$5

PASTORAL CHARM (Foster '75) 15". A lovely rich cream with a lilted form. Standards are veined rose, and falls are overlaid with a rose and blue blend. A decorative fan is outlined in rose-brown and veined gold. Two branches on some with up to 7 blooms. Charmingly fluted. Has pollen and pods. Parentage unknown. \$5
