Greetings!

NUGGETS, my 1976 MDB introduction, has been showing up as one of the outstanding newer MDBs. It led the 1977 list of MDBs receiving the AIS Honorable Mention award with 44 votes, and followed that up by being voted Judges' Choice in a three-way tie for most votes (52) among MDBs. It was the only 1977 HM winner of the MDBs to be voted Judges' Choice. In Austria, it placed fourth among MDBs in the International Competition for Low-Growing Irises. On the show table, it followed up its 1976 placing as one of only two MDBs on the Court of Honor at the Iris Society of Minnesota Early Show by being named Best MDB at the 1977 Northern Illinois Iris Society Early Show. Where will this all lead?

Besides my own 1978 introduction, SNOW SPARKLE, on the following page, I have registered Bonnie Dunbar's seedling 36-65-3M as ALMOND SPICE (MTB), to be introduced in 1979 or 1980. ALMOND SPICE was named Best Seedling at the 1977 Iris Society of Minnesota Early Show, and thus won an AIS Exhibition Certificate.

I also expect to be introducing varieties for Lothar Denkwitz of Hamburg, Germany, who has won several awards for his seedlings in the International Competition in Vienna. The first shipment of plants will be arriving this summer, and I hope to begin releasing the best of the Denkwitz varieties in 1979.

Let me draw your attention to a new feature in this year's catalog - the use of symbols to indicate country of origin on varieties hybridized outside the USA. The key to these symbols, which are used throughout the catalog, is on the bottom of the page listing IRIS PUMILA.

I continue to get inquiries about when WILD BLUEBERRY, my popular 1971 MDB introduction, will be available. WILD BLUEBERRY was raised as a seedling on heavy clay soil in Minnesota, and while not a fast increaser, was reliable there. It seems not to like the acid sand of the present garden in Afton. Stock of WILD BLUEBERRY has now been moved to the heavier loam soil of my Chicago garden, where I hope it will increase sufficiently to allow me to list it again in a year or two.

The commercial and display garden is in Afton, Minnesota, east of St. Paul near the St. Croix River. If you would like to stop by to see the irises, please call my parents, Charlotte and Gus Sindt (also expert irisarians), at (612) 436-7901 for instructions on how to find them. The garden is an official display garden of both the Dwarf and Median Iris Societies. IRIS PUMILA usually begins blooming about the first of May, and there is continuous bloom of dwarfs and/or medians through the tall boarded season which begins about the first of June. You may want to visit during the Dwarf Iris Society tour in Minnesota, recently rescheduled to May 13 and 14.

The Chicago garden is devoted to my hybridizing program. Should you wish to visit here, call me at (312) 528-3064 to arrange a time when I'll be home; I'm in the Lakeview neighborhood of Chicago's North Side, about a mile from Lake Michigan. Blooming season is about a week or two earlier than it is in Afton.

Best wishes for a bloomful iris season in 1978!

NEW FOR 1978

SNOW SPARKLE - Iris pumila (MDB)

Four inches tall, this is an immaculate pure white with a white beard, slightly whiter than its parent, White Mite. The falls do not roll to a point but tend to curl under as do those of White Mite, thus showing the full width of the falls. The flowers thus look like so many little snowballs resting on a bed of green. It is vigorous and floriferous in cold winter climates. The cross was supposed to be (White Mite x Sun Sparkle), but there is nothing of Sun Sparkle (color, relative size, form) evident in this variety and I suspect the bees helped me out with the pollen.

The Minnesota Horticultural Society awarded me its highest award, the Bronze Medal, in 1973, for "achievement in horticulture."

IRIS PUMILA

Garden varieties of purely Iris pumila extraction listed here bloom before all other bearded irises. Though they are classified as Miniature Dwarf Bearded (MOB), they are listed separately because they are so distinct from other MODs. They require cold winters and are not reliable in areas with mild winters. In height they are mostly 3 to 5 inches, so I have omitted height listings. These irises are ideal rock garden subjects.

MINIATURE DWARF BEARDED IRIS (MOB)

MOBs are bearded irises from 0 to 7 inches in height, though there are a number of varieties an inch or two taller registered before these limits were set in 1976 that are properly MOBs also. Generally early blooming, those listed here follow the pure pumilas on the previous page. Most of them prefer cold winters, and a few also do well in areas with mild winters. Older varieties are listed separately on the next page for your convenience. For other MOBs remember to check the list of garden varieties of pure Iris pumila extraction.

STANDARD DWARF BEARDED IRIS (SOB)

SDOs are bearded irises from 8 to 15 inches in height. They are the smallest and earliest of the four median classes, usually blooming after the MOOs and before the IBs. They are widely adapted in many climates and are the smallest bearded irises that are reliable in some areas with mild winters. Older varieties are listed separately on the next page for your convenience.

They are arilbreds (bearded irises of at least $\frac{1}{2}$ aril parentage) generally less than 20" in height. The best show their aril ancestry through such aril characteristics as exotic veins, signal patches, and coloring. Aril medians are often the most adaptable of the arilbreds to a variety of climates and growing conditions.
