


Dear Friends,

As we go in to January we must face the task of putting together our 1978 catalogue.

It's an inbetween time, a time when we're gradually pushing aside memories of our '77 garden year in favour of the planning and anticipated beauty of our '78 garden.

Let's regress for a while into the '77 season. Growth started early in '77 much to our misfortune. Although it's nice to see spring come early and growth start it's almost inevitable that it will be set back by a late frost, and thus it was last spring. The T.B.'s were two weeks advanced when the frost hit stopping the growth of many of the promising bloom stalks and seriously distorting many of the others. What

a disappointment, when many of our newer iris, ones we had never seen in bloom before, failed to send up bloom stalks. A year of built up anticipation waiting for our new aquisitions to show their beauty and all in vain. The frost was followed by hot dry weather forcing rapid growth, causing a much lower bud count and hense a short bloom season.

The shipping season was hot and dry making excellent conditions for drying and shipping.

The fall however was very, very wet causing concern over the wintering of wet rhizomes in soggy soil. It also eliminated our hopes of more grassed walk ways and some landscaping in our main garden as my time had to be concentrated on getting our farm work done and believe me it was a battle.

Regression, however, is fruitless unless there is a lesson to be learned from our mistakes. Let us aim for progress in the anticipation of our '78 garden, if we made mistakes in '77, let's rectify them and make this years garden better and more beautiful than last.

We hope to get at least part of our remaining walkways grassed this spring as well as planting a shrub border around the perimiter of our main garden. These are flowering shrubs with bloom hopefully coinciding with the iris season.

Siberian and older spurias are still in our garden for sale on a pick-up basis only, as there is not enough time avalible for shipping in their prospective seasons.

Our garden is always open. If you are unable to visit us during the bloom season and are in the area at some other time, please stop in, we are always happy to meet and visit with our customers. For those that can't visit us drop us a line and let us know how your garden is growing.

If you belong to a society or any other group and would like to visit the garden, please make arrangements ahead of time.

DEFINITIONS

Blend - - - a combination of two different colors

(one always being yellow).

Bitone - - - two tones of the same color. Self - - - - the same color all over.

Bicolor - - - two colors, light or medium standards

and deeper contrasting falls.

Plicata - - - (pleated) stitched or stippled margin

of color on a white background.

Amoena - - white or near white standards with colored falls.

Variegata - yellow or near yellow standards with deeper falls, either veined or solid tones of brown or purple.

Abbreviations at the end of description indicate American Iris Society awards. HM - Honourable Mention; AM - Award of Merit, 12 awarded each year; DM - Dykes Medal, highest award given, leach year.

The name is followed by the year of introduction and the letters; VE - very early; E - early; EM - early midseason; M - midseason; ML - midseason late; L - late; VL - very late. Numerals indicate height of stem in inches.

There is overlapping, so there is always something blooming. Mid May is the best time to see the smaller iris. June 3rd - 21st. is the best time to see the T.B.

IRIS. - Pliny wrote, nearly two thousand years ago, that "iris" is Egyptian for "eye", and that the name "Iris" signifies "Eye of Heaven".

The word "iris" is Greek for "rainbow". In classic mythology Iris, the rainbow personified, was one of the minor goddesses, and messenger of the greater divinities, particularly of Juno.

CULTURAL INSTRUCTIONS

Planting time - Mid July through mid September. Earlier and later are possible, but earlier will reduce the following years bloom and later will lower the chance of winter survival.

Replant every 3-4 years depending on variety. Plant in a well prepared, clean, sunny location using a fertilizer containing little, if any nitrogen. If manure is to be used it must be completly rotted and worked in well ahead of time.

Plant level with ground surface in clay about 2" deep in sand. Cultivate shallow, iris are shallow rooted.

Water only when planting, no water is needed after this unless it's extremly dry.

A mulch of wheat straw or weed free hay is benificial in winter.

Do not cut foliage back after blooming, but remove bloom stalks with a quick snap. Occasionally remove dead and badly spotted leaves from the outside of the fans.

Insect and disease control - Number ONE rule - remove and burn all dead material from around the iris in the spring. Borer eggs and bacteria spores are on these and can be eliminated only by burning.

<u>Iris borer</u> - Excellent control from Cygon 2E.

Leaf Spot - Controlled by the use of Benlate or Captan.
The two chemicals for borer and leaf spot may be combined and sprayed when the iris are 3-4" high and again when they are 6-8" high.

Bacterial Soft Rot - A soft mushy rot with a very strong oder. Caused by too lush a growth (too much nitrogen), too much water or failure to clean dead leaves in the spring.

REMONANT or REBLOOMING IRIS

Culture of the reblooming iris does not vary too much from that of the spring blooming. They do, however require more water and a little heavier fertilization in late June and July in order to force the growth of the rhizome to a large enough size to support bloom.

Some rebloom begins here in mid-August and continues until a

heavy frost.

We do not know how far north they will rebloom, but they preform well here.
