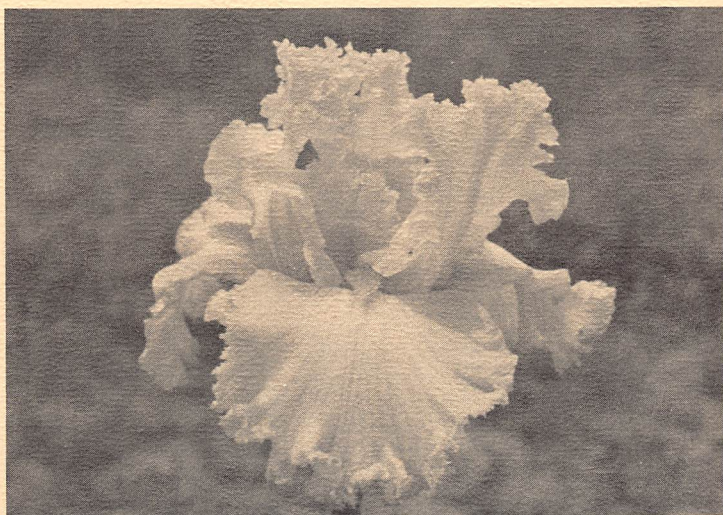

Dear Friends,

Please be sure to include your street address and phone number. Shipments begin July 1st and end July 31st. No orders accepted after July 1st, so please order early!

**EXTRAS:** We usually give 100% extras on orders of \$20 or more. The final choice must be ours because it is impossible to accurately match supply with demand until the last order is in. Please be sure that we know what you already have so we will eliminate those varieties from consideration.

\*1978 INTRODUCTIONS\*

Boardwalk (K. Mohr) TB 38" This new neglecta is a fresh approach to this class. Large perfectly formed flowers have leather thick substance. Stalks are thick and extremely strong. Standards are in ice blue. Falls are a ruffled vivid blue. A must for the neglecta lover. (Coolhead X Margarita) . . . . . \$25

Cypress Point (D. Mohr) TB 34" Like the clear blue skies of California, this sharp ruffled sky blue was named after the world famous northern California point where the land and sea meet. Standards are domed and closed. Falls are arched and touch at the hafts. Every flower is exceptionally well proportioned. (Babbling Brook X Epic) . . . . . \$25

Jamaican Sunset (D. Mohr) TB 34" Like the late evening sun hanging over the dark peaceful tropic waters below, standards are a rich tangerine yellow and falls are a deep violet-blue. The beard reflects the color of the sunset while a broad infused band on the falls reflects the last glimmers of the sun (pastel orange). Ultra contemporary flowers are slightly fluted. Stalks often display three perfect flowers at a time. (Touche X Tambourine) HC "76 . . . . . \$25

Royal Ballet (K. Mohr) TB 38" A much needed addition to the deep royal purple class. The rich color is well set in tehe bubble ruffled flowers, semi flaring falls, and arched domed standards. Endless buds and stalks keeps your ballerina performing gorgeously almost all season. (Matinata? X Dusky Dancer?) RTGA "75 . . . . . \$25

Royal Masterpiece (D.Mohr) TB 38" When grown to perfection—look out! Super ruffled lavender flowers on perfectly branched stalks. Average of up to eleven buds per stalk. Falls flare at a near horizontal position. Standards are gracefully arched and closed. (Pacfic Waters X Vibrant Splendor) RTGA "76 . . . . \$25

Sunshine Express (K. Mohr) TB 33" Super wide petals over lap slightly at the hafts. Each bright sunny flower is sensationally edged with beaucoup lace. You will want to feel the thick crisp substance and run your fingers over the lace. Gives many stalks, buds, and increases rapidly. (Pink Sleigh X Cherub Choir) . . \$25

Autumn Encore (K. Mohr '77) Autumn colors of red-violet splash the borders of this white ground plicata. Dependable rebloomer. Well branched stalks. (Crinoline X (Stepping Out X Cayene Capers))

Baby Face (K. Mohr '77) Imagine three of your favorite Dykes Medal Winners in a glorified heather pink. Exciting? You bet! This new pink resembles its parents in branching, form, color, and flower characteristics. Each stalk is "show branched" with thick wide ruffled flowers. Hardy plants have done exceptionally well surviving the worst of winters. Increases rapidly and produces many stalks. ((Winter Olympics X Rippling Waters) X Pink Taffeta)

Bride's Halo (H. Mohr '73) This dynamic iris has been recognized from coast to coast and over seas. The white self edged in 24K gold of B.H. has become a legend in our time. As a tribute to her, we have pictured her on the back cover of the Fall 1977 AIS Bulletin. (Rainbow X Denver Mint) Top AM '76

Cindy O. (J. Overholser '76) One of the best red bearded whites that has been introduced. Standards are arched, domed, and closed. Falls are semi-flaring and gently ruffled. Excellent bud placement on tall hardy stalks. It is no surprise that Jayne picked this beauty to be named after her grand-daughter. (Champagne Music X Christmas Time)

Kentucky Derby (D. Mohr '76) Each flower is a yummy lemon yellow edged a delicate border of lace. Petals are wide with crispy thick substance. You will find this one outstanding in every respect. (Beaux Arts X New Moon) HM and JC '77

Koala (D. Mohr '76) Smooth creamy flowers are outstandingly wide, ruffled, and fluted. Even the novice iris grower will delight in the large display of endless stalks this rapid increaser produces. (Beaux Arts X New Moon) HM '76

Lady Lovelorn (K. Mohr '77) Beautifully fluted, the falls are broad, and have a unique shade of glowing red-violet. Standards are light silvery-blue and closed. Classically formed flowers are large with crisp enduring substance. (Apropos X Mystic Mood) RTG '76

Peace Dove (D. Mohr '77) An almost white with blue beards. Each stalk carries many of the "dove like" flowers. The smooth curves will leave you with a very tranquil feeling. Branching is excellent as is bud count. (Pacific Waters X Azure Apogee)

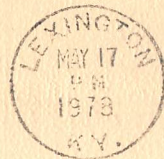
