1983 INTRODUCTIONS

LEMON RINGS (T.Aitken '83) - SDB - 14" M,L,VL
(Cotton Blossom x Solar Flight) Lemon yellow standards form a ruffled cup over very broad flared falls with upturned edges. The white beard is surrounded by a yellow spot, fading to white, then lemon at the petal edges. Excellent plant vigor frequently gives 4 bloomstalks per rhizome, with 4 buds on the primary stalk and 3 buds on secondaries. This gives a very long bloom season, often still in color when the tall bearded begin their show. A reluctant breeder, it makes up for quantity with quality. We are getting a very high percentage of reselect seedlings in orange, pink, yellow and iridescent green!

HELLCAT (T.Aitken '83) IB - 24" M,L,VL HC'82
(Hocus Pocus x Mystique) Name is derived by association from the sturdy blocky two tone blue WWII navy planes. Light blue standards are in sharp contrast to the velvety purple falls. Sturdy bloomstalks carry two or more nicely spaced branches and a double terminal. Flower form is blocky with flared wide falls to provide a distinctive base for the cupped standards. A fertile pod parent, it is stingy on seed quantity. Foliage is well proportioned and healthy. Vigor is moderate, with 4 to 10 increases per rhizome. What more could one ask for from such blue blooded parentage?

CASCADIAN SKIES (T.Aitken '83) - TB - 38" M,L, EC'81
(Cup Race x Stepping Out) Pale blue, flushed deeper at base of petals and stylearms. Blue beard. Tall stalks carry 9 to 11 buds on 3 branches. An unique color among some 300 seedlings in this cross, its quiet elegance did not become apparent until its third bloom season in the reselect beds. It has been a reliable performer through several non-typical spring seasons.

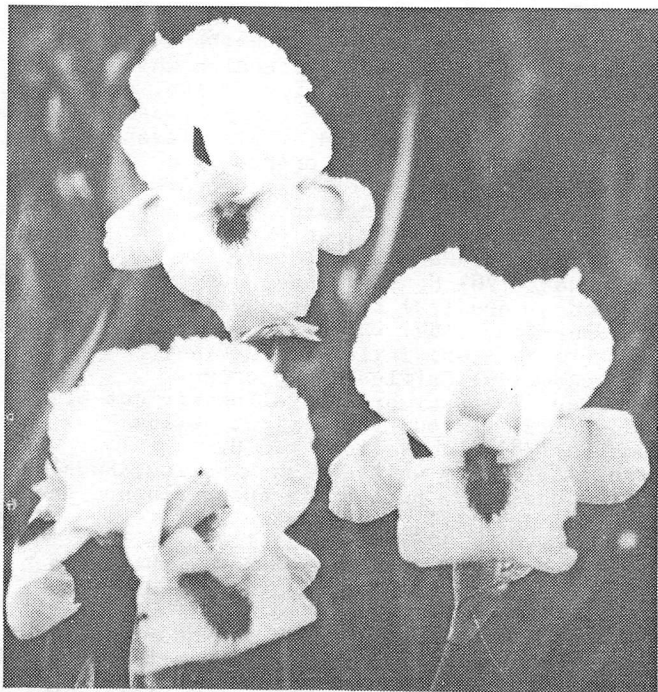

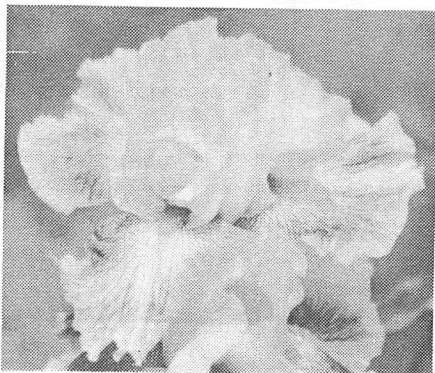

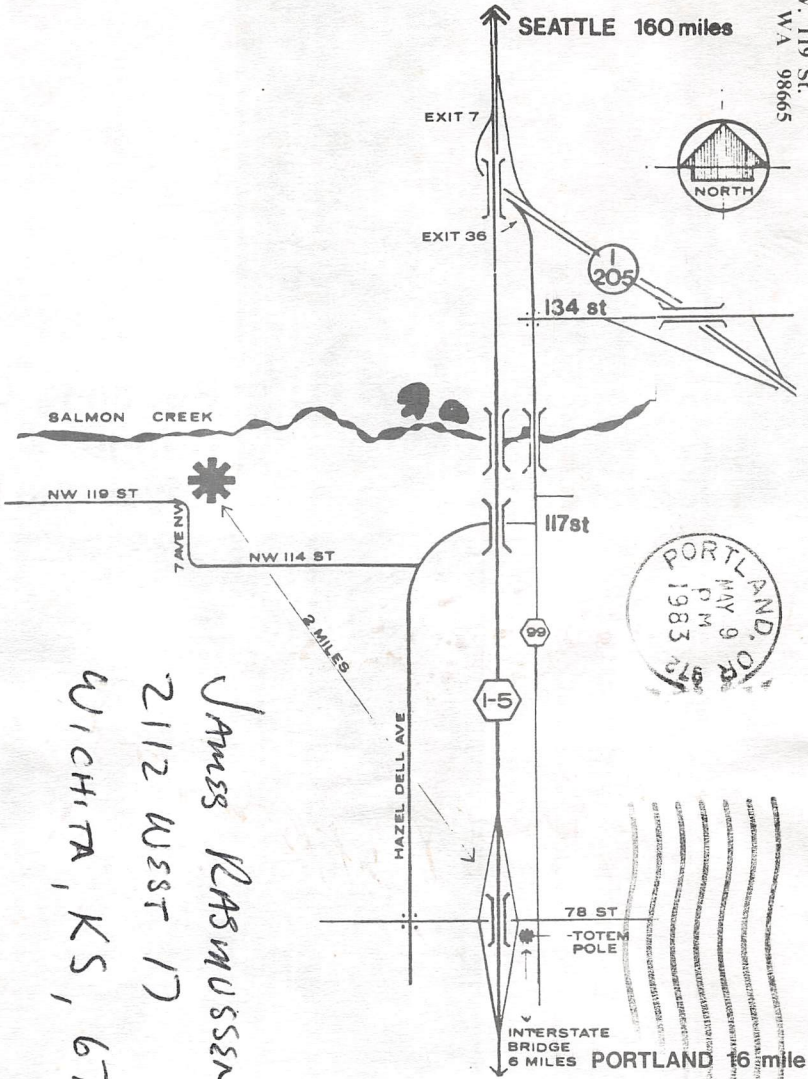
