GARDEN VISITS - The garden is open to the public on weekends during bloom season from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (see map, page 18, for garden location). The garden is locked when not open, so please telephone to make advance arrangements to visit during the times when it is closed.

The peak bloom is expected near the end of April. We are growing 150 named varieties (unlisted, due to insufficient stock), hundreds of select seedlings of many hybridizers, and approximately 3,000 new seedlings. We encourage you to come and enjoy them with us.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT - All orders are acknowledged upon receipt. Due to the large quantity of orders shipped each week, we cannot guarantee you a particular ship date, but you may choose July or August. (Club purchases are an exception.) We grow large quantities of those listed and try not to run out; but invariably, there are exceptions. So early orders are recommended. We DO NOT substitute without your permission.

TERMS - The minimum order is \$15.00, plus shipping (all orders) and state sales tax (Calif. residents only). All orders will be shipped during July and August, and no orders will be accepted after August 31. Prices are based on supply and demand and are discounted as far as possible, due to our long growing season.

BONUS IRIS - This year a special "bonus" plan is being offered. Orders of \$50.00 or more (excluding shipping and taxes, but including both discounts and introductions) will receive one of the following new 1983 introductions absolutely free with each \$50.00 you purchase (one introduction for a \$50.00 order, two for a \$100.00 order, etc.): MEDIEVAL, SIDEWINDER, WIND-SURFER. Orders under \$50.00 will be net without bonus iris.

GUARANTEE - Our stock is guaranteed to be inspected, disease-free, properly labelled, and well grown. Watering is discontinued after bloom season to harden the rhizomes for shipment to cold climates. If you have any problems or are in any way dissatisfied, we will replace or refund if you notify us immediately upon receipt of your plants.

CLUBS, RESALE, OVERSEAS, GIFTS - We are delighted to provide iris for your club to be used at auctions, summer sales, or for pooled orders for your members, and to provide gifts to your friends or loved ones. Resale orders are also available without sales tax if you provide your resale number and business name. Overseas and Canadian orders are limited to \$100 minimum, plus shipping and phytosanitary certificate costs.

INTRODUCTIONS

We are offering the following new iris for 1983; each of them has been grown and observed for at least three years to assure satisfactory performance.

TALL BEARDED

HINDENBURG (Maryott '83) (CAT. #485)

37 inches, mid-season bloom, Sdlg. #E12A.

X This beauty exhibits intense orange with giant orange beards on tall, well branched stalks with triple buds to extend the season. The color is sun-fast, the growth faultless, and the plant is proving to be a superb pod and pollen parent. Our best orange yet. See the spring 1983 AIS Bulletin for a color photo.

HYPNOTIC (Maryott '83) (CAT. #486)

37 inches, mid/late season bloom, Sdlg. #D83H.

The tremendous substance & heavy fluted ruffling makes this blue amoena exceptional. A sib to both Glistening Icicle and Scented Nutmeg, this iris offers tremendous garden appeal, as well as lots of show potential. (Full Tide X President Farnsworth).....\$30.00

MEDIEVAL (Maryott '83) (CAT. #480)

38 inches, mid-season and reblooming, Sdlg. #D204A.

The standards are stitched lilac purple on white ground. The falls have lilac-purple speckles on pink ground. The form is excellent, and the plant reblooms regularly. The branching and bud count is adequate in the spring but poor on the reblooming stalks. Attracts much attention. (Roundup X Porta Villa).....\$25.00

SCENTED NUTMEG (Maryott '83) (CAT. #484)

36 inches, mid-season bloom, Sdlg. #D83G.

The color is smooth and pleasing deep blue-lavender, the branching superb, and the growth excellent. The excitement comes from the absolute, intense fragrance of nutmeg (If only this iris were brown!) which permeates the entire garden when this beauty is blooming.

SIDEWINDER (Maryott '83) (CAT. #482)

37 inches, mid-season, Sdlg. #E80A.

This iris was the best of about 200 seedlings from Cinnamon Sand and Siva Siva. It has brown plicata markings on white ground, lovely form and branching, and grows very strong. The form is wide and ruffled, and it's much loved by the public.

The standards are medium true blue with white midribs, and the falls are the same, with a prominent white flash around the totally white beard. The stem is well branched with seven or eight buds, and the growth is excellent. This really unique iris will certainly never be considered "just another blue".

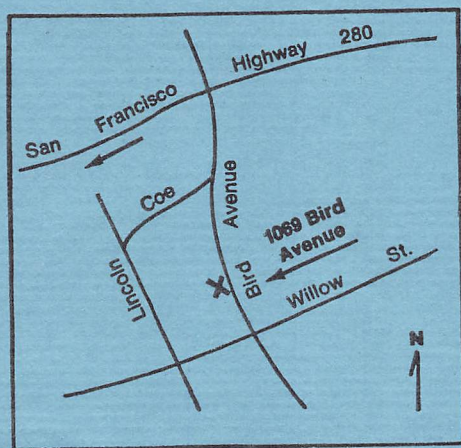
