SALES: All sales of non-plant items are final unless the product is defective. We are not responsible for damage to items during shipment.

MINIMUM ORDER: We require a \$5.00 minimum order plus handling charge.

SHIPPING: All orders are shipped via UPS unless you specify otherwise. UPS shipment is free. Any other means of shipment you suggest, such as Postal Service or air shipment, will be billed at the time of shipment at current rates.

HANDLING: All orders, regardless of whether they are shipped or picked up, must include a \$2.00 handling charge to cover processing expenses.

Beardless iris will be shipped the first two weeks of September. Lilies will be shipped the first two weeks of October. Other items will be shipped at our discretion.

Our plants are grown in a very harsh climate. Our temperatures range from -40°F in winter to up to 100°F in the summer. As you can see, we have a harsh climate, not a California one. Couple our harsh climate with a short growing season and you get very hardy plants that are not necessarily huge like west coast plants. Our plants do, however, produce the same quality bloom as plants from other parts of the country. Remember we produce hardy "Cold Climate Iris" not California or west coast plants. Our gardens are inspected by the state annually and our plants are disinfected prior to shipment.

GUARANTEE

We guarantee all plants you receive to be healthy, free of disease, pests and true to name. If you have a problem with your order please notify us enclosing any plants in question, within 10 days of receipt. Of course, you would not expect us to be held responsible for your climactic conditions or cultural practices.
