Please remember Siberians and Spurias CAN NOT be shipped with bearded iris, so please use the appropriate order form.

CULTURAL INSTRUCTION FOR BEARDED IRIS

<u>PLANTING TIME</u> - Mid July through mid September. Earlier and later are possible, but earlier will reduce the following years bloom and later will lower the chance of winter survival.

Replant every 3 - 4 years depending on variety. Plant in a well prepared, clean, sunny location using a fertilizer containing very little nitrogen, 5-20-20. If manure is to be used it must be completely rotted and worked in well ahead of time. Wood ash is benificial being very high in many trace elements.

Plant level with ground surface in clay, about 2" deep in sand. Cultivate shallow,

iris are shallow rooted.

Water only when planting, no water is needed after this, unless it's extremely dry. A mulch of wheat straw or weed free hay is benificial in winter.

Do not cut foliage back after blooming, but remove bloom stalks with a quick snap. Occasionally remove dead and badly spotted leaves from the out side of the fams.

Foliage may be cut back to 6 - 7" from ground in late fall.

INSECT and DISEASE CONTROL - Number ONE rule - remove and burn all dead material from around the iris in the spring. Borer eggs and fungus spores of leaf spot are on these and can be eliminated only by burning.

IRIS BORER - Excellent control from Cygon 2E as instructed. Watch for ragged leaves

or water streaking, dig out borer.

LEAF SPOT - Controlled by the use of Benlate or Captan. The two chemicals for borer and leaf spot may be combined and sprayed when the iris are 3 - 4" high and again when they are 6 - 8" high. Clean badly infected leaves from edge of fans.

BACTERIAL SOFT ROT - A soft mushy rot with a very strong odor. Caused by too lush a growth, too rich a soil, too much water, failure to clean dead leaves in the spring or injury to rhizome allowing the bacteria a place to become established. Agricultural gypsum sprinkled on infected plants is benificial. Dig and scrape rot from rhizome and air dry for several days. Dust with sulpher or gypsum and replant.

DEFINITIONS

Blend - - - A combination of two different colors.

Bitone - - Two tones of the same color.

Self - - - The same color all over.

Bicolor - - Two colors, light or medium standards & deeper contrasting falls.

Plicata - - (Pleated) stitched or stippled margin of color on a white background.

Amoena - - White or near white standards with colored falls.

Variegata - Yellow or near yellow standards with deeper falls, either veined or solid tones of brown or purple.

Abbreviations at the end of description indicate American Iris Society Awards.

HM - Honorable Mention; AM - Award of Merit, 12 awarded each year;

DM - Dykes Medal, highest award given, 1 each year.

The name is followed by the year of introduction and the letters: VE - very early; E - early; EM - early midseason; M - midseason;

ML - midseason late; L - late; VL - very late.

Numerals indicate height of stem in inches.

A top quality preformer. A raffled self, the color of spring wisteria, tucked & ruffled with tangerine beards. AM

ADDED PRAISE - '76, ML, 40" 4.50
A tall ruffled wisteria blue with creamy beards. Ridgid well branched stalks. AM

ADORA - '81 6.75
Warm white with very broad light violet plicata markings.

AFTER HOURS - '81, M, 34" 8.50
An elegant ruffled rich deep blue self.

AGEAN STAR - '72, EM, 30" 3.00 A well branched deep violet plicata on a pure white ground. Beards are violet. HM

AGNES MOORHEAD - '78 6.50 Large lavender-blue.

ALL THAT JAZZ - '82, EM, 36" 17.50

A beautiful, bright variegata with domed standards of clear, brassy buttercup yellow. The flared falls are a brilliant iris red laced & curled revealing bright yellow underside.

ALOHA - '73, EM, 35"

Soft carmine-orchid with tangerine beards & buff-apricot hafts. HM

ALPINE CASTLE - '79 8.00
White standards with white falls blending from blue to rich violet at the margins.
Beards are bright red.

AMBER BEAUTY - '82, ML, 37" 18.00
A different & vigorous rich amber yellow with an effervescence of its own. The flowers of superb substance are waved & scalloped in an ideally ruffled form.
The magnificent stems have two double socketed branches plus spur & an average of 7 buds each.

AMERICAN HERITAGE - '78, EM, 34" 3.75
A broad band of deep blue-violet plicata
pattern surrounds the spotless white
central areas. Well formed flowers. HM

AMGEL CHIFFON - '78 5.75

A heavily ruffled light blue pink with a greenish white fall blaze& light pink beards.

ANON - '75, M, 36"

Pale orange standards. Falls light amber yellow, lightly speckled brown at hafts, tangerine beards. AM

ANTICIPATION - '77 3.75 A red of blonded burgundy & chocolate. ANTIQUE IVORY - '72m ML, 36" 2.25 A full bodied majestic cream white, enhanced by a well defined margin of lemon gold on both standards & falls. HM

APPRECIATION - '83, M, 38" 12.75
Buff-tan standards with rounded orchid-lavender
falls, smooth sienna brown hafts & yellow
beards. Deeply fluted flowers on well
branched stalks.

APRICOT FRINGE - '78 4,75
Lacy & fringed light apricot self. Closed standards & arched falls. Well branched. HM

ARCTIC FURY - '64, L, 38" 2.00
Pure white self, falls large & lightly
ruffled blooms. AM

ARTISTE - '78 5.00

The standards are amber-apricot with white falls bordered amber-apricot. Henna beards.

ARTWORK - '76, L, 35" 3.00
Rippled standards of peach& warm flesh.
Waved lavender orchid falls. Cream beards
tipped tangerine. Excellent branching. HM

ASGARD - '75, M, 36"
Standards of chilled yellow with falls of evening-violet are bordered by a shadow or brown. HM

AT SUNDOWN - 79, ML 4.75
A fluted & ruffled unique new color presenting a luminous blend of sunburst gold, rose & copper-brown from which emerges a blaze of rich golden tones in the center of each fall. A hardy iris with good growing qualities & ringidly branched stems with 8 to 9 buds per stem.

AUTUMN BLUSH - '84, EM, 33" 20.00 Standards of medium buff-pink with a paler edge. Creamy falls are flared with a distinct greenish cast. Amber rose hafts with a pale pink halo surrounding a stunning sienna beard, well branched.

AUTUMN LEAVES - '74, M, 34" 3.00 Standards blended brown of fallen leaves with yellow at base. Falls are purple, browning at the edges. Well branched. AM

AVAION BAY - '74'
A well branched, rich ruffled blue-birdself.HM

AVANTI - '71
A blended golden apricot.

AZURE LIGHTS - '79, ML, 32" 3.75
A nicely ruffled blue-white with an orchid heart. Flaring falls, heavy substance.

BABBLING BROOK - '66, M, 38" 2.00 Light blue self; excellent form & strong grower with light yellow beards. DM BARELY MOHR - '81, 25" 5.75

A Mohr-type Arilbred. This wide petaled brown bitone favors its tall bearded mother, but the tell tale small, dark feather signals at the tip of the bronze beards confirm the Aril father parentage.

BAROQUE PRELUDE - '74 3.50 Vigorous yellow amoena.

BASHFUL BRIDE - '80, L, 33" 7.75
A delicate light pink self with ruffled, fluted falls & pink beards. Exceptional branching.

BAYBERRY CANDLE - 68, ML, 36" 2.00
A bicolor with rich chartrense lime
standards & burnished brighter toned
olive green falls. Gold bearts. AM

BEAUX ARTS - '69, MI, 36" 2.75 A laced & ruffled color between phlox pink & mallow purple. Falls slightly lighter with saturn red beards. HM

BECKON - '74, M, 40"

A plicata of rosy violet purple on pure white. Yellow beards & superior branching.

BEIGE RUFFLES - '77 4.00
A ruffled beige pink with a greenish white blaze in falls.

BELL CANTO - '81, ML, 38" 9.75
A majesticly ruffled & fluted full toned lilac-orchid. A plant combining stalk, branching & buds to bring a glorious climax to your spring garden. HM

BENGAL TIGER - '81, EM, 36" 9.75 Clear bright yellow standards, falls yellow with maroon stripes, edged yellow; beards yellow.

BERRY WINE - '80 8.00
A showy varigata with yellow standards
& purplish red falls.

BEVERLY SILLS - '79, M, 36" 9.75
The vivid coral tones give lift to the pulsing pink. Generously proportioned flowers are edged with crochet-lace & ruffles. Produces several bloom stalks per shizome. AM

BICENTENNIAL - '76, ML, 42" 6.75
Bright gold standards & white falls with lacy gold edges & yellow beards. Tender.AM

BIG REACH 75 3.00 Big, wife light peach-aprice on short sturdy stems. HM

BLACK DRAGON - '82, ML, 36" 10.75 A very intense black with redium sized flowers & extra velvety falls. BLAZING SADDLES - '78, EM, 34" 4.75 Full buff-gold standards, rounded by ruby red falls & bronze beards. A bright variegata. HM

BIONDE CODDESS - '74, M, 36" 3.00 A well formed, well branched strawberry blonde. Bushy tangerine beards.

BLUE BARON - '62, M, 40" 2.00
A massive marine blue pleasingly ruffled, superb branching & high bud count. AM

BLUE LUSTER - '73, ML, 36" 2.50 Giant rich blue self with lustrous blue beards. Excellent substance & branching. High bud count. AM

BLUE REFLECTION - '74, M, 38" 2.50
A waxy pure light blue, well branched & budded. HM

BLUSHING LEMON - '73, ML, 32" 2.50 Yellow standards with pink flush at midrib.AM

BOLD ACCENT - '78, M, 36" 5.00 Very bright bicolor with closed standards of rich gold & flaring falls of bright purple. Well ruffled. HM

BOLD HOUR - '75, ML, 38" 3.00 A rare color combination of glossy, vivid rose-plum with contrasting white standards. Pert flaring falls.

BRASS TRIO - '82 10.75
Brassy mustard gold standards, falls
same blazzed violet.

BRANDY - '81, EM, 36"

A color combination of toasted melon, tan, pink & rosy brown, with gold highlights.

Extremely ruffled & fluted, carried on sturdy well branched stalks. From the time the flower opens until it folds you'll see each color mentioned. HM

BRIDAL CROWN - '81, ML, 35" 13.75
A richly embelished clear sparkling white gloriously crowned with a heavy gold wash on the standards & intense golden yellow markings at the hafts. Starch-like substance. HM

BRIDES HAIO - '73, EM, 36" 3.75
An immaculately clean satin-white flower with a 1/8" border of burnished gold.
Lightly laced frilled & very showy. DM

BRIGHT REFLECTION - '78 5.75
A full ruffled deep salmon self with fire red beards.

A strikingly different amoena. The standards are near white, upright & closed. Falls are erythrite red with slightly waved petals with a precise border of 1/8" white.

A happy flamingo pink with an enthralling singular beauty. A smooth pink self with a flawless branched stem with 3 open flowers at a time.

CHIEF WAUKESHA - '78, M, 38" 4.75 Oxblood red self with reddish beards. Well branched & vigorous. HM

CHILD OF FORTUNE - '79, M, 32" 7.25 A lovely pink with falls overlaid roselilac. Beards are vivid tangerine red.

CINEMA - '82. 8.75
Butter yellow standards texture-veined deeper, falls are white with butter yellow hafts & band.

CHIPPENDALE - '79, VL, 36" 5.75
Terra Cotta to rose blend with golden hafts, a touch of violet in the falls. HM

A medium metallic brown.

CHRISTMAS TIME '65, M, 40" 2.00 Flashy thick red beards in a large, lacy & crimped snow-white iris Well branched.

CHRISTMAS TREASURE - 77 A Ruffled lavender blue standards with white falls & red beards.

Fluffy pale yellow standards. Semi-flaring falls with hafts brushed yellow. Very laced with heavy substance & orange beards. HM

A fluted & ruffled rich golden yellow iris with full standards & nearly horizontal falls. Deserves attention.

A rosy pink blend with good garden carrying power. HM

CLOUD FIRE - '83, M, 35" 15.00 A large & heavily ruffled red bearded white. Well branched with good growing habits & a long bloom season.

CLOCKWORK ORANGE - '83, M, 34" 15.75
A very different but pleasing shade of orange. A very smooth orange with matching beards. Branching isn't perfect but the flowers open like clockwork, extending its bloom season.

COLONIAL COLD - '73, M, 38" 3.00 Yellow infused with antique gold. Bluish beards brushed orange-brown.

COMMUNIQUE - '80, E, 38" 4.00
White ground plicata, lightly edged royal blue, with deep purple hearts. Sturdy stalks, three branches plus terminal.

CONCH - '73, M, 34" 2.00
A melon to peach pink blend.

CONGRATULATIONS - '83, M, 35" 15.75
A very richly colored iris with blue standards & pansy-violet falls with the fall color bleeding upward into the standards.
Broad & ruffled form with blue beards tipped yellow. Well branched, good bud count.

Wide & ruffled royal purple self with wide
flaring falls & cupped touching standards.HM

CONTRASTING MOODS - '77 3.50 Yellow & lavender bicolor.

COOL OASIS - '81, 32" 7.75 (½ Arilbred) A blue to purple toned Aril. Rounded & bulging light violet standards, recurving falls have a redder appearance & exhibit small black signals under dark bronze beards. HM

Very curly & ruffled. HM

An absolute stand-out reguardless of weather.

COPPER FLAME - '78 Deep copper. COPPER NUGET - '80, M, 35" 9.00 A stunning bright copper-chocolate. The finely proportioned flowers are lightly & uniformly fluted. A remarkable beauty. CORAL BEAUTY - '81 Near white standards, with peachy apricot falls edged in white topped with tangerine COSMIC DANCE - '82, EM, 35" A self of deep rich blue with shades of intense indigo. CULTURAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPURIA IRIS

Spurias are a beardless species ranging in height from 3-4' tall. They are attractive orchid like flowers blooming in early July. The color range is wide, reds, pinks, yellows, bronzes, blues, purples and various combinations.

FALL SHIPMENT ONLY - Shipments will begin in late September or October.

PLEASE ORDER ON FALL ORDER FORM

Plant as soon as possible in full sum as hot temperatures are required for good bloom. Plant one inch deep in heavy soil and two inches in sand. They require good drainage. Plants will be taller once established. Space far enough apart to grow in the same location for 7 to 8 years. Very attractive once established. Will benifit from light applications of fertilizer (10-10-10) or composted manure. DO NOT get fertilizer on rhizome. Cut foliage within 5-6 inches of ground in late September.

Spurias will benifit from the addition of peat moss to the soil. Heavy watering will be benificial in late spring and early summer dry spells.

Diseases are no worry but borer can be a problem. Cygon 2E will control tham if applied when spraying the tall bearded followed by a third spraying in another 7-10 days. Newer varieties listed are in short supply please order early.
