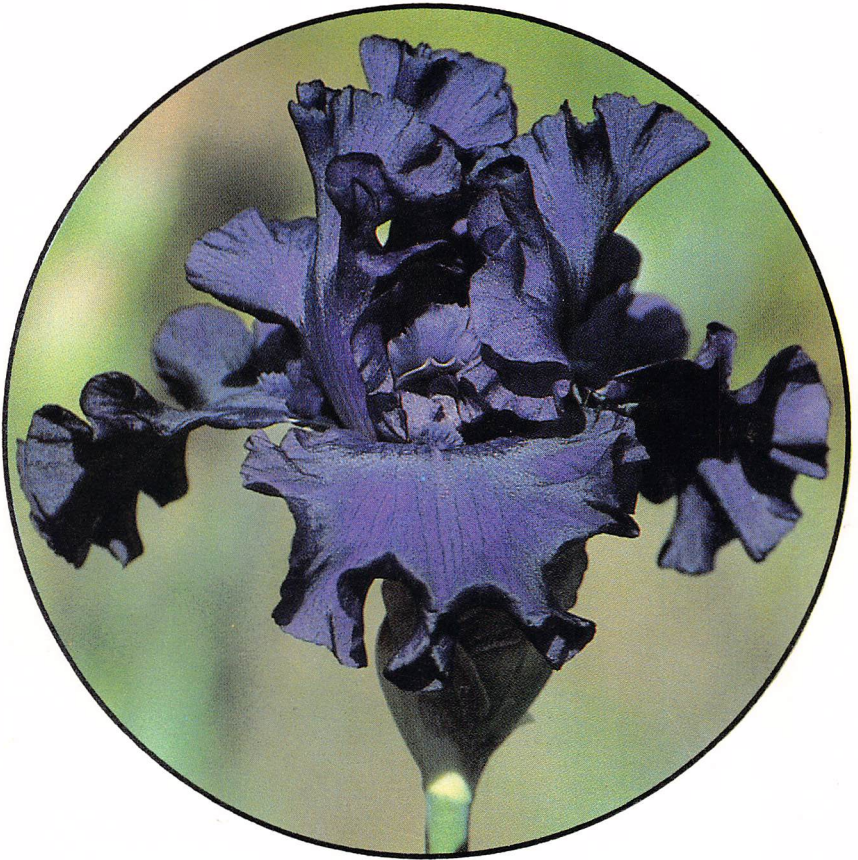

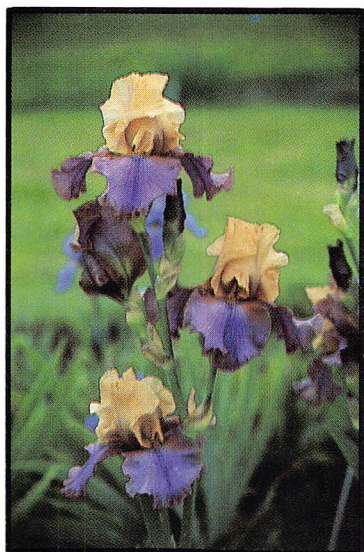

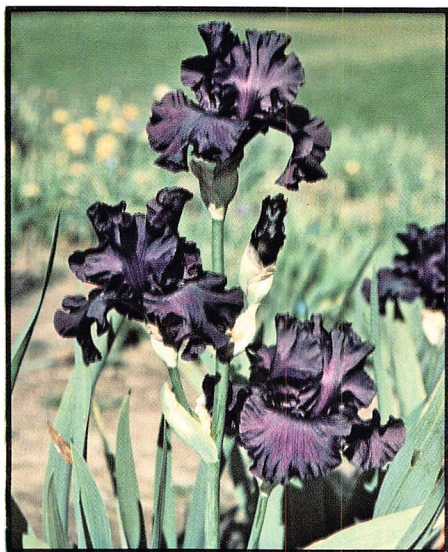

1989 INTRODUCTIONS

GRAPELET (MDB) \$10.00

(Aitken '89) #82M35-3; 5"; ML; (Clays Capers x Dixie Pixie) Very round grape violet flowers look like clusters of grapes. Short foliage is topped off with a heavy cover of blooms at 5". Standards are domed while the falls flare out and curl down slightly at the edges, giving the grape cluster effect. A heavy bloomer in springtime, it has also attempted to rebloom very late in the fall (October) here.

CHERRY FLIRT (SDB) \$10.00

(Aitken '89) #83M11D"; 10", ML; (Cherry Tart x Senor Frog) Wavy blue violet standards are held stiffly erect above very wide, deeply fluted smooth red falls. This unique color combination is a perky and cheerful flirt in early spring. Pod fertile, it is producing some very nice seedlings.

JADE JEWELS (SDB) \$10.00

(Aitken '89) #80-6E; 11-1/2", ML; 1-2 buds (Dixie Pixie x Summer Nights) A creamy smooth green self, on the yellow-green side of the spectrum, this little jewel has closed standards and flared out falls, lightly curled at the edges. Beard is light violet.

JUNGLE WARRIOR (SDB) \$10.00

(Aitken '89) #82M3-7; 14", ML; 1-2 buds (Helter Skelter x Dixie Pixie) An extremely vigorous, rugged and floriferous standout in the seedling patch, it can be spotted from afar for its unique color combination. Well formed, lightly ruffled and domed standards are orchid violet deepening toward the petal base. Widely flared falls are a unique amber gold, with light orchid beards. Two year clumps are spectacular. (See color photo in April AIS Bulletin).

PACER (IB) \$15.00

(Aitken '89) #80-16C; 20", M; 4-5 buds; (Cotton Blossom x Stepping Out) A reliable performer in the IB class, it produces nice showstalks with excellent plicata contrast. Color is much like its TB parent, Stepping Out, with dark blue/violet banding over a snowy white ground. Flower form is excellent, with closed standards and nicely proportioned falls.

HOT SPICE (IB) \$15.00

(Aitken '89) #83M12; 25", M; 5-6 buds; (Peppermill x Flamenco) This is the most sensational color that we have seen on an IB plicata! HOT, hot yellow ground on the falls is surrounded by deep rich solid brown banding and matching solid brown standards. The busy orchre gold beard is surrounded by a small white flash. Excellent flower form and proportion make this an altogether soul satisfying combination. (See color photo in April AIS Bulletin).

MAID OF ORANGE (BB) \$20.00

(Aitken '89) #83M40-B; 25" (Apricota x Shoop orange BB sdlg.) In 1986 we introduced Doris Greenwood's APRICOTA as a 28" 'small tall', even though it usually grew in class for a border bearded. This seedling from Apricota has been consistent at 25" for three bloom season, in both one and two year clumps. Flowers have tightly closed standards and lightly liting falls, and flower size is properly petite for the stem height. Bud count is excellent at 7-9 buds. Color is creamy smooth orange, slightly lighter around the bright orange beard. The plant has properly proportioned foliage and vigorous growth habits. It is pod fertile and floriferous.

JUNGLE PRINCESS (TB) \$30.00

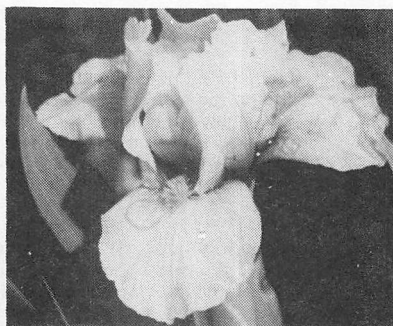
(Aitken '89) #80-69; 36", M, 7-9 buds; (Spartan x Mystique) This was a rather startling discovery from among our many thousands of Mystique seedlings. The closed standards are a smooth buckskin tan in sharp contrast to the well rounded, smooth, solid deep enamel red falls. Top this off with an ochre-orange beard, and you have one classy iris! A consistent performer here, the colors appeared even smoother and brighter at the Phoenix convention, with the added heat.

GYRO (TB) \$35.00

Aitken '89) #80-137D, 38", M, 8 buds; (Navy Strut x Mystique) Following the introduction of ORBITER in 1985, this sibling, under code name of "super ruffles", was carefully secreted away in the back rows of the seedling patch to allow time and distance to separate these great rivals. In the cold climate test gardens of Nebraska and Washington, and under number, GYRO was consistently selected as the best of several siblings. We are now pleased to offer this exceptional specimen in deep, sleek violet/blue, alive with deeply fluted bubble ruffles, firm substance and presented on fine showstalks. A pronounced sweet grape fragrance is also an asset to this fine plant. (See color photo in April AIS Bulletin).

Smallest and earliest of the bearded irises. Profuse bloom on excellent compact rock garden and border plants. Prefers cold winter climate.

- Terms - Cash or check with order (WA residents add 7.6% sales tax).
- Minimum mail order - \$10.00, plus shipping. Please add \$3.00 for orders west of the Mississippi and \$3.50 east of the Mississippi. For air mail, please add an additional \$.50 per rhizome. Where possible, we ship UPS, so please include full street address and phone number (no P.O. boxes). For areas east of the Great Lakes, we recommend you send an *additional* \$3.00 for 2-day air (UPS) - particularly when ordering beardless irises.
- Orders will be shipped mid July through September. Local customers may pick up orders at the garden to save cost of shipping.
- Siberian, Japanese and Pacific Coast irises are dug and shipped in September and October. A separate shipping charge is required for this group.
- We guarantee plants to be true to name and in healthy condition.
- Bonus plants will be included on all bearded iris orders. This will be our choice, based on order size and availability, but your suggestions are welcome.
- Orders from outside mainland USA, add \$12.00 for plant inspection certificate (phytosanitary). Airmail postage will be charged at actual cost.
