IRIS LISTINGS for 1989

GREETINGS:

While I have grown many hundreds of iris cultivars of most types over the past several years, this is my first attempt to list anything for sale. Already I realize that the lateness of getting this list into your hands puts me at a disadvantage. If you choose to order, I can perhaps compensate by being very generous with extras. Please list the varieties you prefer, in order for me to give you the most pleasure.

This list is complicated by the fact that it includes three types of irises requiring three different shipping dates. Bearded irises are shipped starting in July and continuing into August; Spurias go out in September and Pacificas (PCN's) are last to go, into October. Local orders may be picked up without extra handling charges, but for those involving shipping, please add \$2.50 for each type of iris ordered. California residents should add 6% sales tax.

There comes a time when one has to place limitations on what can be accomplished, given parameters of daylight hours, space and capabilities. That time has come for me and I have decided to devote my efforts to the improvement of spurias as a first priority. This includes looking at more than 6,000 seedlings at this time. The variation is absolutely phenomenal and I am fascinated by the modifications in this flower that are forthcoming in the near future. I am introducing three spurias and one Pacifica (PCN) this year. Because I have a Ph.D. in Genetics, I quite often look at a seedling for its genetic potential rather than its immediate impact on the beholder. Consequently, I retain those segregates which have some outstanding characteristic but do not qualify for release. I call them "Exceptional Genotypes" and rather than hoard them for myself, I offer them to anyone who may wish to incorporate their special factor(s) into a more suitable cultivar.

I am offering seeds too! Note the details at the end of this list.

Of the irises offered here, I find the Bearded irises are easiest to grow, then the Spurias and most care is required for Pacificas. They require an acid soil, but because I have not always provided it, I suspect there is variable tolerance among segregates of crosses I have made. Some plants on soil not adjusted for acidity simply die beside others that survive.

Maturity class and reblooming ability (RE) is indicated at the end of each description. Cultural instructions will be provided if requested.

INTRODUCTIONS for 1989

BALI BALI (Jenkins'89) Sdlg. A33-34A: Struttin' X Yellow Wings. SPU, 39" (100 cm), M. This is the first seedling from this cross that I said "yes yes" to. The standards are ivory and the flaring yellow falls have an ivory margin. Extemely fertile both ways and an excellent propagator.....\$20.00

FINALLY FREE (Jenkins'89) Sdlg. SP87A: Yellow Wings X unknown but it could be Dawn Candle. SPU, 44" (111 cm), VE. Both standards and falls are a clear yellow. When I looked into my garden on March 30, 1988; the day my son died and was "finally free" of his diabetes, this seedling was holding six flowers open on one bloom stalk. It is a very vigorous grower too and has extra large rhizomes and thick leaves. I suspect it may have an extra chromosome because nearly always some seeds abort in pods where it is a parent.....\$20.00

LIVELY ONE (Jenkins'89) Sdlg. B5-1F: Equality X Ada Perry. SPU, 46" (117 cm), M. The standards are white and the lightly ruffled falls are white with a large yellow signal. One rhizome in my garden produced four bloom stalks the first year following planting and it seemed to me that it was quite a "lively one". Fertile.....\$20.00

RHETT'S MEMORY (Jenkins'89) Sdlg. B11-4A: San Gregorio sib X Californian. CA, 12" (31 cm), EM. This is a bright purple flower with a cream colored blaze. It always blooms in March in Salinas to remind me of my son Rhett who died in a diabetic coma during that month. It even bloomed again in July last year but I don't know if it will be consistent in that respect. The V-shaped stigmatic lip readily accepts pollen.....\$6.00

EXCEPTIONAL GENOTYPES (Bearded)

Sdlg. T37-75C: Crimson King X Intuition. 28" (71 cm), VE & RE. This deep-violet self with yellow-tipped beard hairs, blooms every other month in Salinas and is the most prolific propagator I have seen. The foliage is very clean and never shows a sign of rust with infested cultivars all around. The flower form is terrible but the vigor and immunity to rust may be transmitted to a better type.....\$5.00

Sdlg. T37-22A: Crimson King X Brass Tacks. 10" (25+ cm), E & RE. This dark purple dwarf reblooms and is also a run-away propagator. Unlike its Crimson King parent the pollen will function on taller cultivars.....\$3.00

EXCEPTIONAL GENOTYPES (Pacifica PCN)

Sdlg. B30-225: Santa Rita X Montara. 13" (33 cm), E-M. If you want to improve the propagating ability of your "natives" this is the parent to use. Montara is a prolific multiplier but this offspring far exceeds its parent. Following the first year of bloom the plant was divided into thirty clones. No other seedling out of 3000 was that prolific. The flower is light yellow with a purple wash and some stippling. Some people even like it. Fertile both ways.....\$3.00

Sdlg. B29-8A: Rio Del Mar X Deepening Shadows. 20" (51 cm), E-M. This tall seedling displays an excessive amount of branching with a potential of seven or more flowers per bloom stalk. The color is a deep purple self with a small cream colored flash surrounded by an area of almost black. The flower form is good but its substance is not able to withstand high temperatures. Fertile and may be useful if you want to transmit the branching character.....\$3.00

SEEDS SEEDS SEEDS

Spuria, PCN, or Tall Bearded seeds from controlled pollinations @ \$1.00 for 25 or \$2.00 for 75. Open-pollinated seeds from only Spuria and PCN's @ \$1.00 for 200. I have a wide range of combinations, and pedigrees will be provided, but rather than me sending a detailed list you should request a specific character of interest and I will try to send the combination that, in the genetic shuffle, will give you some chance of selecting that character. Examples might be:


Spurias--dwarf stature, specific colors, wide falls or crosses with LENKORAN, from Dr. Rodionenko in the Soviet Union.
PCN's--ruffled flowers, numerous buds, indehiscent seed pods or extremely vigorous growth habit.

Tall Bearded--reblooming or variations in color, ruffling, lacyness and rust resistance.

All of the above seeds should be stratified or planted outside in the fall, which is the normal time for these types of plants! Seeds may be ordered at any time.
