

If you specify a particular ship date we will endeavor to comply. We do try to ship orders to the northern latitudes and high altitudes as early in the season as possible. These short season climates need a head start. If you need early delivery please send your order in early.

## PLEASE CALL FIRST

Our tall bearded iris normally bloom in late May and early June, although this year it looks as if we may be headed for an early season. If you are ready to plant this spring and want to visit during the blooming season we do have plants that you can dig yourself for \$3.50 (including tax). These are priced by the clump (at least 2 or 3 divisions), are not labeled with a name, and need to be planted within a few days. It is always advisable to call before coming to check on availability. Bloom season is the only time of the year you may purchase "cash & carry". The rest of our plants are available only by prepaid orders.

#### PRICING

Previous customers will note that we have changed our pricing structure. We no longer have our discount schedule for larger orders. Instead we have tried to reduce most of the individual prices. Orders over \$50.00 are entitled to a 10% savings. "Extra for good measure" bonus plants will still be included with your order. We hope this new arrangement will prove less confusing, still offer you good value, and help us serve the iris-loving public for another 87 years.

## TRIED AND TRUE OLD AND NEW

#### **TALL BEARDED (TB)**

All the iris in our main listing below are Tall Bearded, with stalks over 28" tall and as high as 40". Their time of bloom ranges from mid April in the southern states to late June in the far north and high elevations. Most varieties bloom once a year in the spring, although some will rebloom in the summer & fall in warm climates. For an explanation of our descriptions please see "Terms & Abbreviations".




