#### JANUARY DOOR PRIZE IRIS

BRUSSELS (T. Johnson 2004) TB - Medium blue standards and ice white falls. Very pale blue beards.

COCONUT FROSTY (Aitken 2007) BB - White self with a slight orange flush on the hafts. Orange tipped bright yellow beards.

EXPERIMENT (P. Black 2005) SDB - Burnished greenish gold self with dark indigo blue beards.

FLEECE AS WHITE (P. Black 2005) BB - Stark white self with pale yellow beards.

LIGHT AND SHADOW (P. Black 2003) TB - Big. blocky, blue-violet on white plicata. White patch around the pale violet beards.

MERCURY RISING (K. Keppel 2007) TB - Bright yellow standards. Falls are oxblood with a bright vellow blaze around the vellow beards.

PICTURE BOOK (J. Ghio 2007) TB - Medium pink standards. The falls are the same color, but lighten toward the center. Tangerine beards.

ROYAL SNOWCAP (Schreiner's 2007) TB - Cool. pristine white standards. Velvety plum-purple falls with razor thin white bands.

CHAIN REACTION (R. Tasco 2007) AB RE - Rosy plum purple standards. Rosy burgundy falls. Brownish black signal around violet tipped brown beards.
