Since then they have held important positions in our club and Region 14. As committed irisarians, they have attended the AIS national conventions regularly.

Joe was the MDIS club president from 2002-2004, and 2007-2009. During his tenure, he produced a club guidebook of the many club jobs, board responsibilities, procedures and the annual events coordination guidelines that continues to be a useful reference for our volunteers. He has also coordinated our door prize iris purchases in past years.

At the regional level, Josie was the Region 14 Secretary for RVP, Margaret Sutton from 2001 to 2003, Betty Coyle from 2004 to 2006 and Lynn Williams in 2007. In addition, her natural charm and approachable manner cannot be underestimated as she greets club members and the general public at our events. She forms quick social rapport, especially with our youth members. Many times I have watched her in action, and I am sure she could sell a rhizome to anyone.

For years Joe and Josie have dug their irises and donated them to our club for our main fund raiser at the Benicia Peddler's Fair. There have been years we would have been without enough stock to sell without their generosity and excellent stock. Like other

clubs, every September we pot up any remaining irises. Regularly Joe and Josie would provide the soil (individually measured and double bagged) and pots for the club growers, asking nothing in return. At our show last year, Jo and Josie arrived when the show was nearly over to help with the teardown and clean up. This year, when we needed her, Josie came and did all the placing of the iris in preparation for competition. When you need a helping hand, Joe and Josie are there."
