EXCELSIS—TB, 36", M. S. clean tawny pink, nearly closed; F. same, slightly lighter in center below tangerine beard, with plicata haft-markings and all around buttonhole stitching at edges in brownish purple. (Waymark X Mayberry pink-ground plic sdlg.) \$25.00

IRISH CROCHET—BB, 24", M-ML. Lacy light chartreuse self of good form; nearly closed S. and flaring F., slightly washed sienna when first open. (Plicata sdlg. x pink sdlg.) X Green Flare. \$20.00

LA ZAMBO—BB, 27", M-L. Black with slightly reddish cast in some lights. Flower is a little large for height, but has nicely closed S. and flaring F. with some ruffling. (Black Rose x Ecstatic Night) X Dusky Dancer. \$20.00

PEACHES ALA MODE—BB, 25", EM-ML. Closed white S., shaded peach at midrib and base; F. peach, soft yellow hafts, and tangerine-orange beard. Near perfect branching, so even with 4 open flowers, there is no bunching or crushing; 2 buds per socket; 3 in terminal; lower branch often rebranched; up to 12 or 14 buds. (Youthful Charm X Java Dove). \$20.00

YORK AND LANCASTER—TB, 28-9", EM-M. Pure white S., slightly domed; flaring orchid to lilac-rose F. with small amount of white veining around yellow beard. Usually is within limits for BB, but occasionally gets a bit taller. (Pipes of Pan x Orchids and Snow). \$20.00
