



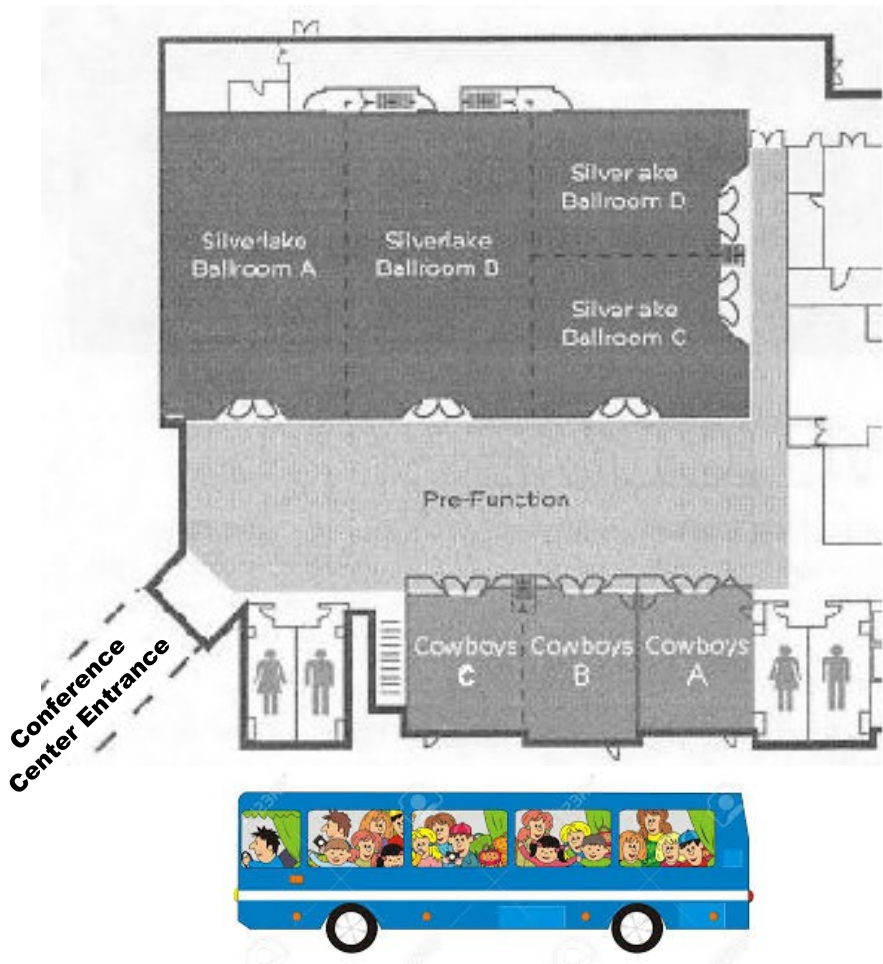

# A Quick Guide To Your Convention

This convention book is your guide to convention programs and garden tours. It contains the daily schedule of events with times and places of meetings.

**NAME TAGS:** Please wear your convention name tag at all times in the hotel, on the buses, and in the gardens. It serves as your ticket to all paid events and each day's lunch. Your meal tickets are in your registration packet with your name badge.

**BALLOTS:** Voting Ballots for The President's Cup, The Franklin Cook Memorial Cup, The Ben Hager Cup, The Lloyd Zurbrigg-Clarence Mahan Award, The Gerald Richardson Award, and Fifteen Favorite Irises are on the perforated pages at the back of this book (pages 99 and 101) Please complete them Saturday afternoon on your ride back to the hotel. Give them to your bus captain or deposit them before 5:00 PM at the Convention Registration desk. Winners will be announced at the Sunday Awards Brunch.

**GARDEN TOURS BUS ASSIGNMENT:** Bus assignments are made at the time of check-in at the Convention Registration Desk. If you have not received your assignment, please return to the Convention Registration Desk as soon as possible to complete this set-up. You will ride on the same bus for both days of tours.

**GARDEN TOURS:** Tours of the convention guest gardens will take place on Friday and Saturday. You will board the bus with the corresponding color/name that you chose at check-in. Please do not switch buses.

**IRIS REGIONS:** In-Region iris are designated with a **RED DOT** on the garden marker. In-Region hybridizers and their cultivars are identified in this book **in bold**.

**GUEST IRIS DESIGNATIONS:** A named iris with no date in the Year column means it is a named seedling.

**SMOKING:** Smoking is prohibited in the Courtyard By Marriott Hotel, on the buses, and in the host gardens.

# **Safety Acknowledgment**

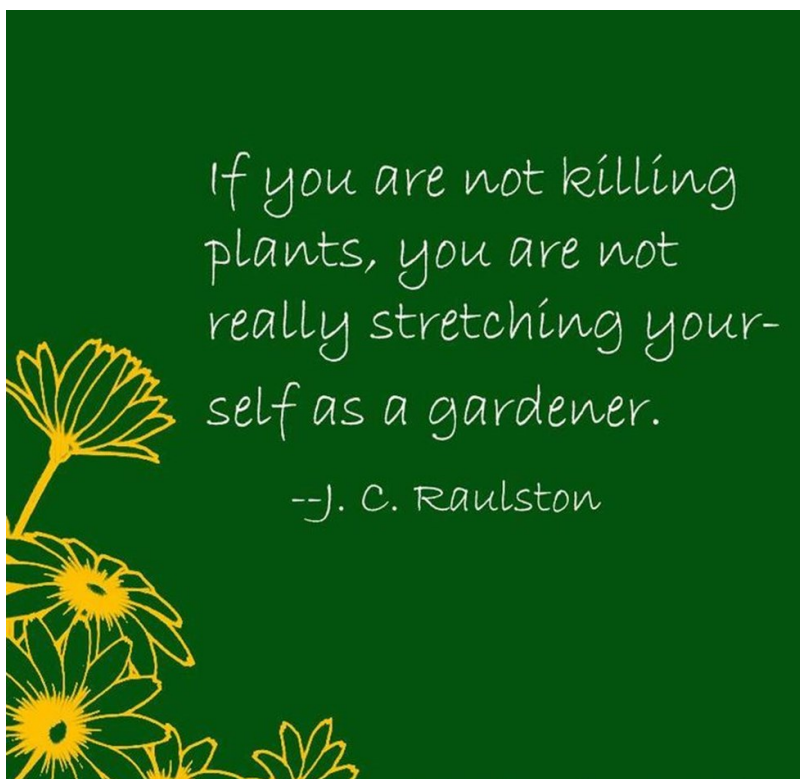
## **Liability Waiver and Release of Claims**

# Bearded and Beardless Iris Panel Presentations

This convention will feature two sets of short presentations by noted irisarians.

You may have heard their names or grow some of their iris. Here is your chance to meet them in person.

Friday evening will concentrate on bearded irises. We will hear from hybridizers Howie Dash, Lynda Miller, Bob Skaggs and Delane H. Langton. Howie will discuss growing aril and aril bred iris. Lynda will focus on MTBs and the trials of working with tets. Bob will talk on breeding iris in the Midwest. And Delane will introduce his new focus on developing early cold zone rebloomers.

Saturday evening will concentrate on beardless irises. Chad Harris will talk about the cultural requirement of *Iris ensata* (Japanese irises). Steve Poole will describe his work with Louisiana irises starting with *Iris brevicaulis*. Lee Walker will discuss the development of tetraploid Japanese irises. Finally, Robert Treadway will speak on conversion efforts involving Louisiana iris species plus and efforts to save registered hybrids.

Profiles of each of the speakers follow.

## BEARDED IRIS PRESENTATION SPEAKERS



### HOWARD (HOWIE) DASH

Howie is president of The Aril Society International and Second

Vice President of the American Iris Society. He lived in Las Cruces, NM where he hybridized arilbred and tall bearded irises. He sells his introductions through Picacho Mountain Iris.

Howie will talk about growing aril and arilbred irises in your garden.

## BEARDED IRIS PRESENTATION SPEAKERS



### LYNDA MILLER

When I was trying to help a woman from Australia identify an iris, in the middle of the conversation over messenger, she asked me if I was the Lynda Miller that was the queen of MTBs. I laughed then told her yes. I always considered Mary Dunderman the queen but she passed away over 35 years ago so I guess I'm the queen now.

I started hybridizing in 1971 in Indiana. Since we lived in an area that was heavy in MDBs, that was the second class of bearded iris I worked with, tall bearded being the first. Our region had the best MTB hybridizer at the time so my first judges training was on MTBs. I worked in diploids for years until my husband made a tet cross that



yielded an in-class tet. (Most of the time they were too large). Using that cross I started making my own crosses with tet MTBs. My plan at the time was to take other people's too large tets and shrink them down into class. Moving to Oregon 15 years ago speeded up the hybridizing process. Now my main focus is to get a black MTB with a red beard; every year I am getting closer. I've won four Williamson-White Awards, the last being for Moose Tracks. And yes I work with tall bearded iris, Football Hero, my 2015 introduction, won the Dykes last year. At the present I am working on improving horned iris.

I will be talking about modern MTBs and the trials of working with tets since I am doing more work on them than any other class.



## BEARDED IRIS PRESENTATION SPEAKERS



### BOB SKAGGS

I started growing iris 30 years ago. My wife and I caught the iris virus shortly there after. Our garden has grown each year since, taking up about 2 acres of the family farm. Peaceful Valley Garden became a commercial garden 15 years ago. We grow about 1300 named iris and about 3000 seedlings, along with 800 varieties of daylilies and about 700 varieties of daffodils.

I started hybridizing about 25 years ago, under the tutelage of Dave Niswonger and Al Roderick. When you belong to multiple plant societies with Dave and Al, it's not long before you start dabbing pollen. Not only do I hybridize iris, I also do daffodils and daylilies.

I introduced my first iris in 2011. A tall bearded named "Marilyn's Skirt". Since then I have introduced 12 more iris with another 5 being introduced this year. My new introductions can be found at Stout Gardens at Dancing Tree.

I have held the position of president of two different iris clubs as well as every other officer position. I served as assistant RVP of Region 18, and have served on the Region 18 Board of Directors several times. And I have served on the Board of Directors of TBIS.

Our garden has been an AIS National Convention tour garden once and a Region 18 Convention tour garden three times.

I am going to speak about "Breeding Bearded Iris in the Midwest."

### DELANE H. LANGTON

Delane is a retired Bodyshop owner who, with his wife Jane Tibbs, owns and operates Eagle Ridge Iris Gardens in Montana, zone 4b, where they grow close to 7,000 varieties of most classes of iris.

Delane is a past two term President of his local Big Sky Iris Club, served two terms as North Central Director of HIPS, and is currently serving as a director for DIS, TBIS and the Reblooming Iris Society.

Delane and his local crew are also preparing to host the 2025 Convention of the American Iris Society in Billings, Montana.

Delane will discuss Eagle Ridge Iris Gardens overview and hybridizing efforts since 2018 with a new focus on developing early cold zone rebloomers.

Known for his work hybridizing *Iris ensata*, Japanese iris and a close relative *Iris laevigata*. These are the water loving iris native to Asia.

Chad will be discussing the cultural needs of *Iris ensata* to ensure a healthy blooming plant for your garden.

### STEVE POOLE

Steve Poole is a retired high school chemistry and physics teacher with a Bachelor of Arts in Organic Chemistry and German. He did master's work in botany, specializing in soybean breeding.

Steve has been an AIS member since 1969 and is a Master Judge, Past President of Southern Illinois Iris Society and past RVP of Region 09. He has published several articles in the AIS Bulletin and other iris journals. He began hybridizing and introducing TB irises in the mid 1970's and estimates he has evaluated

approximately 50,000 seedlings. Since 2008, he has been hybridizing LA irises using *Iris brevicaulis* and has upcoming LA introductions.

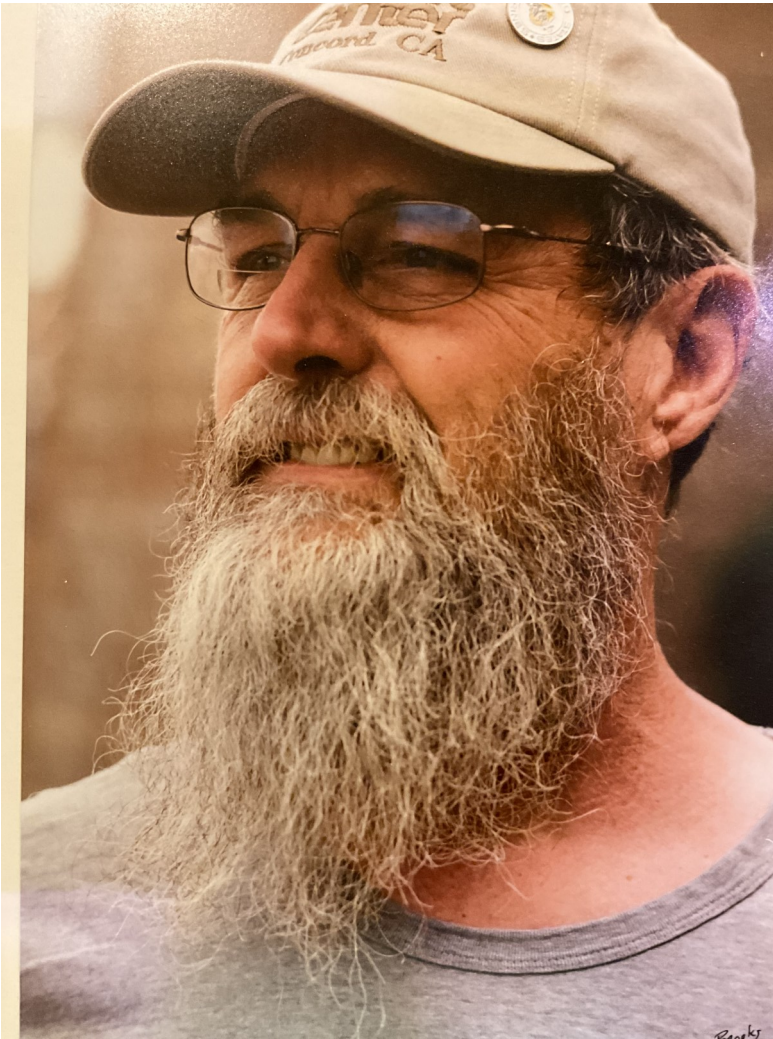
Currently he is working on converting pseudata iris cultivars from diploid to tetraploid by treating the increase meristems.

Steve will be discussing the results of his work hybridizing LA irises over three generations, beginning with an *Iris brevicaulis* collected from Southern Illinois, and the possible impact that might have on future LA hybridizing.





## BEARDLESS IRIS PRESENTATION SPEAKERS



### LEE WALKER

Lee was born in Palmer, Alaska and grew up in northern California. After receiving his Bachelor and Master of Science from U.C. Berkeley, he joined the US Marine Corps, completing Officers Candidate School and two tours of duty in Vietnam. After the Marines, Lee went back to school at U.C. Davis and finished his post-graduate work in genetics.



Lee began hybridizing Japanese and Spuria iris in the mid-'80's. In 1989 he moved to the Tenmile area of Southern Oregon and established Twilight Iris Gardens. For the last twenty-five years he has worked with converting diploid Japanese iris to tetraploid and developing a pollinating process that increases their seed production. Lee has also worked with Lilies, Daylilies, Gladiolas, MDB, SDB, IB, and TB iris, as well as Siberians and X-Crosses.

In search of pH appropriate irrigation water Lee and Betsy moved to just outside of Roseburg, Oregon early in 2017. He also retired from a career as an advisor to the U.S. Government.

Lee received the Eric Nies metal for his introduction of 'Solar Fusion' in 2012, and 'Red War Cloud' in 2019.

He received the inaugural "David Niswonger Trophy", a Spuria Iris Society Convention award, for 'Red War Cloud' in 2017. Lee has been an active member of both the Oregon Trails Iris Society, and the Greater Portland Iris Society for years. Additionally, he has served on the OTIS Board of Directors for many years.

Dr. Walker has been giving talks and seminars for decades, including sharing the keynote address for the Japanese Iris Society with Dr. Currier McEwen in 1999. Lee slowed down enough to become an AIS Iris Judge in 2017

Lee will briefly discuss the past thirty years of the development of tetraploid Japanese Iris, the people who were involved in that work, and what the future may hold for tetraploid Japanese iris.

The minnow farmer and fledgling hybridizer has held several positions on the SLI Board and was President of SLI for two terms, President of Central Arkansas Iris Society, RVP of Region 22, and an AIS Master Judge.

The program is an update on the expansion of the preservation and conversation efforts involving species plus an introduction of new efforts to save registered hybrids.

# GARDEN ETHICS

1. Leave unnecessary bags, purses, and other large items on the bus. If you take a camera bag, set it down before you take photos.
2. Wear clothing that is not likely to damage the flowers.
3. Do not touch, move, or groom any plant FOR ANY REASON without permission of the garden owner.
4. Stay on the established walkways or paths. Do not wander freely among the plants in the beds.
5. Do not lift plant labels for better viewing or photos without the permission of the garden owner.
6. If you encounter a mislabeled iris, do not turn the tag around or write on the label. Notify the garden owner as soon as possible.
7. Never smoke in the garden.
8. Leave your shovel, clippers, and tweezers at home.
9. Carry away or dispose of properly, in available trash receptacles ,all your trash.
10. Use the available Port-A-Potties or the facilities on the bus. Unless an emergency, do not ask the garden owner to use their facilities.
11. Treat the host's garden the way you would like your garden treated.
12. Spread out in the gardens. Try not to congregate in large groups that block the walkways.
13. When judges training is being given, do not interrupt with loud talk or push through to view the plants they are studying.
14. Be respectful of photographers taking photos.

# Adverse Garden Events

Mother Nature was very unkind to our host gardens. We had the Texas Snowpocalypse (extended sub-zero ice and snow) in February of 2021, just a mere 4-6 months after the guest plants were planted; In late April-early May of 2021, just after bloom, something resembling botrytis went through the guest beds in most all the host gardens taking out most of the plants the Snowpocalypse weakened. Many plants were totally lost, others lost all existing rhizomes, but put out new babies that fall. Heavy rains just before summer heat triggered bacterial soft rot in high gear. Thankfully it got very hot quickly enough to stop it, but we had record summer heat in 2021 followed by rain, rain and more rain. Another cold winter in 2021-2022 followed by deluge style spring rains did in many of the struggling new growth plants still alive. The final straw was the 2022 summer to end all summers, with extreme heat and drought for over 8 weeks straight.

The victims of these adverse garden events are not in the guest beds, but are listed at the end of each garden's guest irises. Replacement plants and substitution plants were planted in their places in the fall of 2021 and 2022. These are indicated by colored squares before their names – orange for 1 year plants (planted 2022), blue for 2 year plants (planted 2021). Original plants have no indicator.

## SEEDLINGS and REGISTERED IRIS

Seedlings are notated with “sdlg” in the year column.

Iris with an “R” in front of the year are registered, but do not have an introduction year.

Both were verified against the AIS Online Iris Register as of March 20, 2023.

Connie collects rainwater and saves it for the JI's. Connie also enjoys growing a small collection of variegated foliage irises.

Besides being a member of the Iris Society of Dallas, Connie also serves as President of the East Texas Iris Society and they maintain two public gardens in the area.

This convention is her third time being a tour garden for an AIS Convention. She hosts local garden club tours and countless visitors each year during bloom season.

Dell built all the beds and walkways throughout her garden, including the 3 new convention beds. The garden is wheelchair friendly with paved surface access to all beds. She loves garden art, which you will find throughout all the beds. The guest beds are somewhat small, only hosting 145 guest irises, but you will have lots to see as her private collection includes over 400 aril and arilbred irises, around 30 miniature dwarfs, 350+ medians (SDB, IB, MTB, BB), 500ish Tall bearded, 140+ Louisianas, about 60 spurias, 20 some Japanese, and 40 odd Species-X and Siberians. Hopefully the Red Buckeye, the weeping Red Bud, and Texas Rain trees will also be in bloom along with the clematis vines, various daffodils, and bluebonnets.

The Shady Spot is located about an hour north of the Dallas/Fort Worth metro area focused primarily on raising irises of many classes. The garden is the result of a lifelong passion for gardening, flowers and animals. I moved to this location in 2008 and have been designing, building, digging and planting ever since. The iris collection features over 2,500 named varieties from the newest introductions to many old historic varieties, including many rarities. I grow all the bearded classes plus Louisianas, Japanese, Spurias, Siberians and an assortment of species and Species-Xs. I also hold the master National Collection of MTB irises, with over 600 varieties currently growing. The irises are interspersed in beds planted with shrubs, perennials and annuals that are drought tolerant and Texas tough. Each year I typically add several hundred different varieties so the scenery is always changing! When the flowers aren't blooming,, there are plenty of horses, goats, poultry, pet birds and other critters to keep things interesting.

The garden is open to visitors during the iris bloom season, typically between April and mid-May, or any other time of the year by appointment. Please call or email prior to a visit to ensure the gate is open. I no longer sell commercially so have no website or catalog at this time.

# CONVENTION AWARDS DESCRIPTION

Voting Ballots for the President's Cup, the Franklin Cook Memorial Cup, the Ben Hager Cup, the Lloyd Zurbrigg-Clarence Mahan Award, the Gerald Richardson Award, and your Fifteen Favorite Irises are on the two perforated pages at the end of the book. Please complete them Saturday afternoon on your way back to the hotel. Give them to your bus captain or deposit them in the ballot box before 5:00 pm at the Convention Registration Desk. Willers will be announced at the Sunday Awards Brunch.

## THE PRESIDENT'S CUP

The **PRESIDENT'S CUP** is awarded annually during the AIS national meeting. Eligibility is restricted to introduced irises originated within the host region for that year's national meeting, or by a hybridizer whose garden is included on the meeting's official convention tour, regardless of its location. Irises must have been seen growing and in bloom in the meeting's official tour gardens, but need not be official "Guest" irises. Each registrant may vote for one variety, and the President's Cup is awarded to the iris with the largest number of votes. *Eligible iris are marked by a **RED DOT** on the tag.*

## The FRANKLIN-COOK MEMORIAL CUP

All introduced irises seen growing and in bloom in the official tour gardens of the meeting are eligible for the **Franklin Cook Memorial Cup** EXCEPT irises originated within the host region for that year's national meeting, or by a hybridizer whose garden is included on the



meeting's official convention tour, regardless of its location. Irises considered need not be official "Guest" iris. Each registrant may vote for only one variety, and the Franklin Cook Memorial Cup is awarded to the iris receiving the greatest number of votes from the registered attendees.

## **The BEN HAGER CUP**

All introduced median irises (SDB, IB, MTB, and BB) seen growing and blooming in the official tour gardens of the meeting are eligible for the **Ben Hager Cup**. Irises considered need not be official "Guest" irises. Each registrant may vote for one variety and the Ben Hager Cup is awarded to the median iris receiving the largest number of votes.

## **The LLOYD ZURBRIGG—CLARENCE MAHOAN CUP**

The **Lloyd Zurbrigg - Clarence Mahan Cup** is awarded for the best seedling seen at convention. Presented by Region 4 in honor of two of its distinguished members, Lloyd Zurbrigg, hybridizer of reblooming irises, and Clarence Mahan, hybridizer and past president of AIS.

## **THE GERALD RICHARDSON AWARD**

The **Gerald Richardson Award** is the newest AIS Convention Award, and the only convention award given to a garden. It is awarded to a privately maintained host garden. An integrated garden is defined as a garden bed composed of iris and companion plants that displays the iris to their best effect as a landscape plant. *The Ford, Reed, and Schneider gardens are eligible.*
