From its Origination in 1947 as the Presidents' Cup thru the name change in 1956 to the Franklin Cook Memorial Cup, the cup was awarded to the best introduced Iris with no regional origination distinction. In 1966 the Franklin Cook Memorial Cup was assigned to the best outside the host Region Iris and a new award, the President's Cup, was assigned to the best inside the host Region Iris.
